Romans 12:5 NLT

...Since we are all one body in Christ, we belong to each other, and each of us needs all the others.

We all need people in our lives – I need people for 5 reasons:

1. I Need People Who Will *Walk* With Me.

Genesis 2:18 NLT

It is not good for the man to be alone...

There's an old African proverb, 'When you run alone, you run fast. But when you run together, you run far.'

Hebrews 10:25 NLT

And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

Community is God's answer to loneliness.

1 Corinthians 14:26, 30-31 Message

When you gather, each one of you be prepared with something useful for all: Sing a hymn, teach a lesson, tell a story, lead a prayer, provide an insight...Take your turn, with no one person taking over. That way...you all learn from each other.

Ephesians 4:16 NLT

As each part does its work, it helps the other parts grow, so Christ's whole body is healthy and growing and full of love."

2. I Need People Who Will Work With Me.

Ephesians 2:10 NLT

For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.

Ecclesiastes 4:9 NKJV

Two *are* better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor.

Galatians 6:10 Message

3. I Need People Who Will *Fight* For Me.

Philippians 2:4 NKJV

1 Peter 3:8 LB

You should be like one big family, full of sympathy toward each other...

Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Message

5. I Need People Who Will *Partner* With Me.

John 15:4-5 Message

Live in me. Make your home in me just as I do in you. In the same way that a branch can't bear grapes by itself but only by being joined to the vine, you can't bear fruit unless you are joined with me.
