- 'The question is not will you be, the question of what type of influence will you be?
- You can have a negative influence and leave a scar you know they were there because of the pain the caused.
- You can have negative influence and leave a smudge you know they were there because of the mess they left behind.
- You can have a powerful influence and leave an impact you know they were there because of the helped you and changed you.

1. You have to own the Mandate.

You are Salt

- No salt the food is bland.
- Too much salt and that's all you can taste.
- The right amount perfection.

You are Light

- Light guides, light reveals and light brings out the detail.
- For the most part light operates the same way The light serves to illuminate the world around it.
- Light brings out the color brings out the details shows the beauty.
- No Light We live in the Dark.
- Too much light and it's blinding.
- The right amount perfection.

You are the Salt of the Earth - You are the light of the World

- Salt in the earth is actually a harmful thing so this is not about location.
- Salt of the earth and light of the World is about people.
- The people of the earth aren't the salt and light Jesus is addressing His followers to be salt and light in the world around them.
- Our mandate is influence positive life giving influence people should be better when they hang with us - our communities should be better because of us - our world should be better.

Jesus gives three illustrations of how we can diminish our influence - or create negative influence - Salt losing its flavor - a city in seclusion and a lamp concealed.

Salt losing its flavour -

- The word used here to describe salt losing its flavor means Become foolish, non-sense, disorder, insipid.
- Romans 1:22 "and they began to think up foolish ideas ..."
- 1 Cor 1:20 "God has made the wisdom of this world look foolish. "Nothing will destroy your influence quicker than crazy - nothing will destroy your influence quicker than weird.

Matt 5:11 "God blesses you when people mock you and persecute you and lie about you and say all sorts of evil things against you because you are my followers"

A city in seclusion

A city is not built on a hill to hide, it is in the hill to be seen by all.

"I have given them your word. And the world hates them because they do not belong to the world, just as I do not belong to the world. I'm not asking you to take them out of the world, but to keep them safe from the evil one. They do not belong to this world any more than I do. Make them holy by your truth; teach them your word, which is truth. Just as you sent me into the world, I am sending them into the world." John 17:14-18 NLT

A lamp concealed.

- You don't light a lamp to cover it, you put it on a table and allow it to bring light to the darkness.
- God hasn't called you to be a concealed Christian.

"For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes—the Jew first and also the Gentile." Romans 1:16 NLT

- Very few of God's heroes felt up to the task.
 - Moses a speech issue
 - o Gideon a confidence issue
 - Mary a situational issue
 - Even Jesus tried to side step His first miracle.

A lamp is placed on a lamp stand so it can give light to the whole house.

That they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

- it's not a contradiction it's about a focus
- one focuses on ourselves being seen doing good things for our own reward and our own glory the other is on people being helped and God getting the glory.
