You see a judge from a legal punitive perspective rather than a relational.

C. An intellectual picture of God.

### 3. What do we need to know to regain spiritual health?

A. You were made to be loved!

## **Ephesians 1:4 NKJV**

just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

#### 1 John 4:16-19

<sup>16</sup> And we have known and believed the love that God has for us.
