Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the Day of Judgment; **because as He is, so are we in this world.**

Today, almost all color printing utilizes a process called "color separation." Like the least common denominator in mathematics, the entire palette of colors needed to produce an image is reduced to four components: cyan, magenta, yellow and black. These translucent colors are printed one on top of another in varying amounts, producing the desired hues. All four colours are needed to create full colour images.

Likewise, there are four Gospels that help us to see a full expression of who Jesus is.

Jesus came not only to show us who God is, but also to reveal what a man full of God looks like.

1. Gospel of Matthew JESUS the Lion - REIGN
