5 Levels People Live On:

- 1. Doing what you HATE.
- 2. Doing what you DO.
- 3. Doing what you LOVE.
- 4. Doing what GOD loves.
- 5. Doing what YOU and GOD love.

A Disciple Has:

- 1. **Focus**. Begin to narrow down what's important and what's not in life.
- 2. **Peace**. You're no longer striving in life; you're settled in your heart. Peace with God, peace with yourself.
- 3. **Potential**. You discover the gifts God has placed in you. It's the purposes of God that releases the greatest potential.
- 4. **Endurance**. If you know where you are going you're most likely to push through obstacles.
- 5. **Passion**. People with no passion have no mission in life. Show me an apathetic person, I will show you someone who doesn't understand his purpose. Purpose fuels passion.

Questions I Must Answer to Living a Missional Life

1. Calling Question: Do I believe that God is calling me to accomplish something specific?

Rom. 8:28 NKJV

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose.

We can interpret this verse two ways. Firstly, ultimately whatever bad things happen God can use them to produce something good in me, and I will fulfill His purpose in me.

Rom. 8:28 NKJV

And we know that all things work together for <u>THE BAD</u> to those who <u>DON'T</u> love God, to those who are the called according to <u>THEIR OWN</u> purpose.

- 2. **Burden Question:** What do I feel needs to change that I am constantly carrying a burden for?
- 3. **Price Question:** Am I willing to pay the price to fulfil God's mission in my life?

Luke 14:25-33 NKJV

Now great multitudes went with Him. And He turned and said to them, ²⁶ "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple. ²⁷ And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple. ²⁸ For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has enough to finish it—²⁹ lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, ³⁰ saying, "This man began to build and was not able to finish.' 31 Or what king. going to make war against another king, does not sit down first and consider whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? ³² Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks conditions of peace. 33 So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple.
