## TOGETHER GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Ephesians 1:1-10. What is God's Word saying to you in this passage? What is God's heart for His people?

In verse 1, Paul speaks of being an apostle “by the will of God.” Why do you think this was important for him to emphasize? What was his life like before Christ and how did the Lord change him?

Why is it important to know that every Christian is a saint? Have you ever viewed yourself as a saint? Why or why not is it difficult to see yourself (and others!) as a saint?

Are there any believers in your life that you have trouble treating as a saint? How would Jesus want to change our hearts?

Grace is the foundation and beginning of our faith, and Peace is the fulfillment and the end of our faith. Describe how both grace AND peace are being worked out in your life (i.e. Do you see it working, is it non-existent, is it easy or hard, do you have trouble giving or receiving grace and peace- or both?)
