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## TOGETHER GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Matthew 14:1-21. What is God's Word saying to you in this passage? What is God's heart for His people?

In Matthew 14:1-12, we see Herod making choices based on personal interest, pleasing people, ignoring his conscience, and living in fear. What are some specific areas in your life that you struggle with these things? How would the Lord want you to handle them in the future?

In just 24 hours (in Matthew 14), Jesus heard of the death of his beloved cousin John the Baptist, he withdrew to be alone, huge crowds immediately interrupted and wanted things from him, he rescued his disciples from an unexpected storm, then everyone brought all their sick to him, performed miracles, healed everyone, his work continued, and he gets challenged and questioned about everything he's doing by the leaders of the day. Have you ever had a day like that? How do you respond? How did Jesus respond? As a group, discuss the best couple of ideas that you can do during "one of those days."

The parallel passage of Jesus feeding the 5,000 is in John 6, where Andrew the disciple pointed out, "There is a boy here who has 5 loaves and 2 fish. But what are they for so many?" The little boy didn't have much, but he offered Jesus his lunch. And look what Jesus did with it! What do you have in your lunch bag? What stops you from offering it? What are some things, gifts, talents, abilities, words, faith, love... that you could offer to Jesus and see multiplied?
