# DETER the enemy by knowing your <u>new</u> <u>identity</u> in Christ Jesus

A sinner	<u>Saved</u> by grace
Dead in sin	Alive to Christ
A slave	But <u>set free</u>
Released	Into a <u>whole new</u> relationship
Struggling	But never <u>alone</u>

## Paul shares our struggle with the old identity (Romans 7)

But I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin. (verse 14)

- I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate, I do. (vs. 15)
- I know that nothing good lives in me... (vs. 18)
- For I have the desire to do what is good but I cannot carry it out. (vs. 18)
- So I find this law at work: When I want to do good, evil is right there with me. (vs. 21)
- ...but I see another law at work in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within my members. (vs. 23)

# DETECT the fuel that reignites your <u>old</u> <u>nature</u>:

Predictable patterns, known weaknesses, sin triggers, dwelling on past mistakes

The Old: <sup>5</sup> Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. <sup>6</sup> Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. <sup>7</sup> You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. <sup>8</sup> But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. <sup>9</sup> Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices <sup>10</sup> and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. "Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all. Colossians 3:5-11 · (
