NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT)

The LORD always keeps his promises;
he is gracious in all he does.

¹⁴ The LORD helps the fallen
and lifts those bent beneath
their loads.

¹⁵ The eyes of all look to you in hope;
you give them their food as they
need it.

¹⁶ When you open your hand,
you satisfy the hunger and thirst
of every living thing.

towdah (toe-*dah*)

An extension of the hand. Thanksgiving.

A confession. A sacrifice of praise.

Thanksgiving for things not yet received.

A choir of worshipers.

**Towdah is not a denial of
the situation you're in.**

**It's the acknowledgment that
God is bigger than your situation.**

Jonah 2:9-10

But I, with shouts of grateful praise
(*towdah*) will sacrifice to you. What I
have vowed I will make good. I will say,
‘Salvation comes from the LORD.’”

And the LORD commanded the fish, and it
vomited Jonah onto dry land.

Psalm 9:10

Those who know your name trust in you,
for you, LORD, have never forsaken those
who seek you.

Philippians 1:6

He who began a good work in you will
carry it on to completion until the day of
Christ Jesus.
