Deuteronomy 1-11 – The Heart – Lesson 1

Intro:

Deut 1:1 - *These are the words that Moses spoke to all Israel beyond the Jordan in the wilderness, in the Arabah opposite Suph, between Paran and Tophel, Laban, Hazereth, and Dizahab.*

Deuteronomy 1:32-33 - *Yet in spite of this word you did not believe the Lord your God, who went before you in the way to seek you out a place to pitch your tents, in fire by night and in the cloud by day, to show you by what way you should go.*

- 2:1 – 3:22 – History of wanderings & return – giants?

- 3:23-29 – Not even Moses

Deuteronomy 3:27 - *Go up to the top of Pisgah and lift up your eyes westward and northward and southward and eastward, and look at it with your eyes, for you shall not go over this Jordan.*

- Chapters 4-6

- 4:1-9 – Listen by keeping & doing ... WHY?

Deuteronomy 4:6-8 - *Keep them and do them, for that will be your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples, who, when they hear all these statutes, will say, 'Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.' 7 For what great nation is there that has a god so near to it as the Lord our God is to us, whenever we call upon him? 8 And what great nation is there, that has statutes and rules so righteous as all this law that I set before you today?*

- 4:10-24 – Back to Horeb – 10 – no idols
- 4:25-31 – If – When statements
- 4:32-40 – Playing the game of Yasab
- 4:41-49 – Preparing for the commandments
- 5:1-33 – The 10 – Sabbath

Deuteronomy 5:15 - *You shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God brought you out from there with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm. Therefore the Lord your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.*

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 - Hear, O

Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 5You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. 6And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. 7You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. 8You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
