In this five session series on the book of Isaiah we are going to cover the disobedience, consequence, salvation and eternal glory for the people of Israel at that time, but also see how Isaiah was pointing to the coming Messiah and the coming glory for those who believe! We do serve a holy God that demands justice, but also a compassionate God that provides a way out and is calling out to us to turn to Him!

Each session includes (60 – 75 minutes):

- ❖ **Share Time:** An opportunity for people to share where they saw God this week. (7 minutes)
- ❖ **Connection Time:** An activity to grow in relationship with each other. (8 minutes)
- ❖ **Worship:** Songs that speak the truth of the session. (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Teaching:** A video clip that dives into the chapter. (10-12 minutes)
- ❖ **Scripture Memory:** Tools to hide the word of God in your heart. (5-7 minutes)
- ❖ **Simple Spiritual Conversation Starters:** Questions that can easily transition to spiritual conversations (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Biblical Prayer:** Prompts to pray Scripture back to God (5 minutes)

Lesson #2 Consequence

What you will need for this lesson:

Have a blindfold and noise cancelling headphones

Setup:

- Have the worship videos and teaching videos pulled up on the computer.
- Prepare the tool for memorizing scripture.
- Put a list of past scriptures on the board to go over.
- Print a copy of the daily tools for each attendee.

Welcome: (Includes Share Time and Fun Friday)

Bring a blindfold and noise cancelling headphones. Try out the fun Friday with your group and lead a person to a specific place. Don't make it too far away, but challenging enough to make it hard.

At Full Send we love to celebrate what God is doing and that is why we want testimony time to be a part of every time we get together. We believe that God has been moving throughout the week and want to celebrate with each other where we saw Him. **Before we start talking about Isaiah let's share what God has been doing in our lives this week!** After a few people have shared praise God for His movement in your lives.

Worship: (Includes Tune In Thursday)

Listening and singing to God is a great way to connect with Him and hear Biblical truths. Encourage your group to either listen or sing along, whatever is best for them. As they engage with each song there will be a few questions to unpack what they heard and experienced.

Word: (Includes Scripture Sunday, Memorize Monday and Watch It Wednesday)

Before we listen to the message from Kara about Isaiah and the message of consequence to Israel lets read Isaiah 6 today.

Encourage people to take notes on the back of their sheet of daily tools as they listen to the teaching. Ask them what stood out to them from the teaching.

Let's memorize Isaiah 6:8 today. This one may be familiar to some. I encourage you to team up with a partner and alternate saying words back and forth. As you get them into your mind you can even say phrases at a time.

And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" Then I said, "Here I am! Send me." Isaiah 6:8

Witness: (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Now that we have read and studied about the consequences of our actions lets talk about some real life situations. Challenge the group to answer the questions as they would, then think about how others may answer the question and how they can turn that into a spiritual conversation.

The questions of the day are Have you ever experienced an unfair consequence? Do you think God gives unfair consequences?

As we process through these questions we hope that each person is prepared and equipped to use these questions in normal everyday conversations throughout the week.

Let's read Isaiah 6:11-12

God is always fair in the consequences He gives and they are for our good to turn us back to Him.

May this section be an encouragement to those who hear it and may the benefits of seeking God be clear!

Closing Prayer: (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

Each week we want to teach people how to pray scripture back to God. Sometimes it is as easy as speaking the text and other times it is using the concepts of the passage to speak what is going on in our lives. **Let's finish our day by praying through Isaiah 6:9-10 and ask God for open eyes and ears.**

Encourage the group to come back with stories of what God did this week and how He worked through these daily tools.

Scripture: Isaiah 6

Topic: Consequence

Scripture Sunday:

Join us today in reading Isaiah 6. How did Isaiah interact with a Holy God and what message did God have for His people?

Memorize Monday:

And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?” Then I said, “Here I am! Send me.” Isaiah 6:8

Table Talk Tuesday:

Talk: Have you ever experienced an unfair consequence? Do you think God gives unfair consequences?

Text: Then I said, “How long, O Lord?” And he said: “Until cities lie waste without inhabitant, and houses without people, and the land is a desolate waste, and the Lord removes people far away, and the forsaken places are many in the midst of the land. Isaiah 6:11-12

Truth: The consequence of God is always fair and is done to turn people to Him!

Fun Friday:

Tonight let’s play a game with our hearing and seeing. You can do this with your family or invite some people over. Have a blindfold and noise cancelling headphones. Start with both headphones and blindfold on and try to get them to go to a certain place in your house. Next only have them blindfold, then only the headphones and finally with neither. Talk about experience and ask how our eyes and ears are doing at listening and seeing God.

Seek Him Saturday:

Pray Isaiah 6:9-10 and ask God to open your eyes and ears where they have been closed so that you can hear His message for you!
