### Welcome: (15 minutes) (Includes our Fun Friday challenge)

Welcome to the series on the book of Acts! The early church gathered together and spent time in fellowship. That fellowship consisted of talking about their common interest in God and what He had been doing in their life. Let's spend some time in fellowship this morning and share what God is doing. (Each week during the welcome time we want to hear where the group saw God at work during the week. Take 5-7 minutes to share some brief stories. Make sure to end this time with praise to God and expectation for the next week)

I have a mission for you and I today and that is to share the story of Jesus in 1 minute or less. I will give you 2 minutes to think through what are the most important aspects of the good news of Jesus. Then we will all share our 1 minute testimony of who Jesus is.

### Worship: (10 minutes) (Includes the Tune in Thursday Songs)

We are going to take a few minutes to listen to two songs and as you listen I want you to answer these questions.

- What do these songs say about our mission as believers?
- What do these songs say about God working in that mission?
- Is there someone that could benefit from these songs in your life?

### Word: (20 minutes) (Includes Scripture Sunday, Memorize Monday and Watch It Wednesday)

- What should be the priority of believers?
- How do we live that out today?
- How can we start being on mission for God better in our area?

Today we are going to use the first letter of each word again to memorize this long memory verse. (Before class put the letters up on the board)

ITGGTSGTTAHGTUWWBITLJC, WWITICSIGW? WHTTTFS. ATGGS, "TTTGAGHGRTLTL."

### **Witness: (10 minutes) (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)**

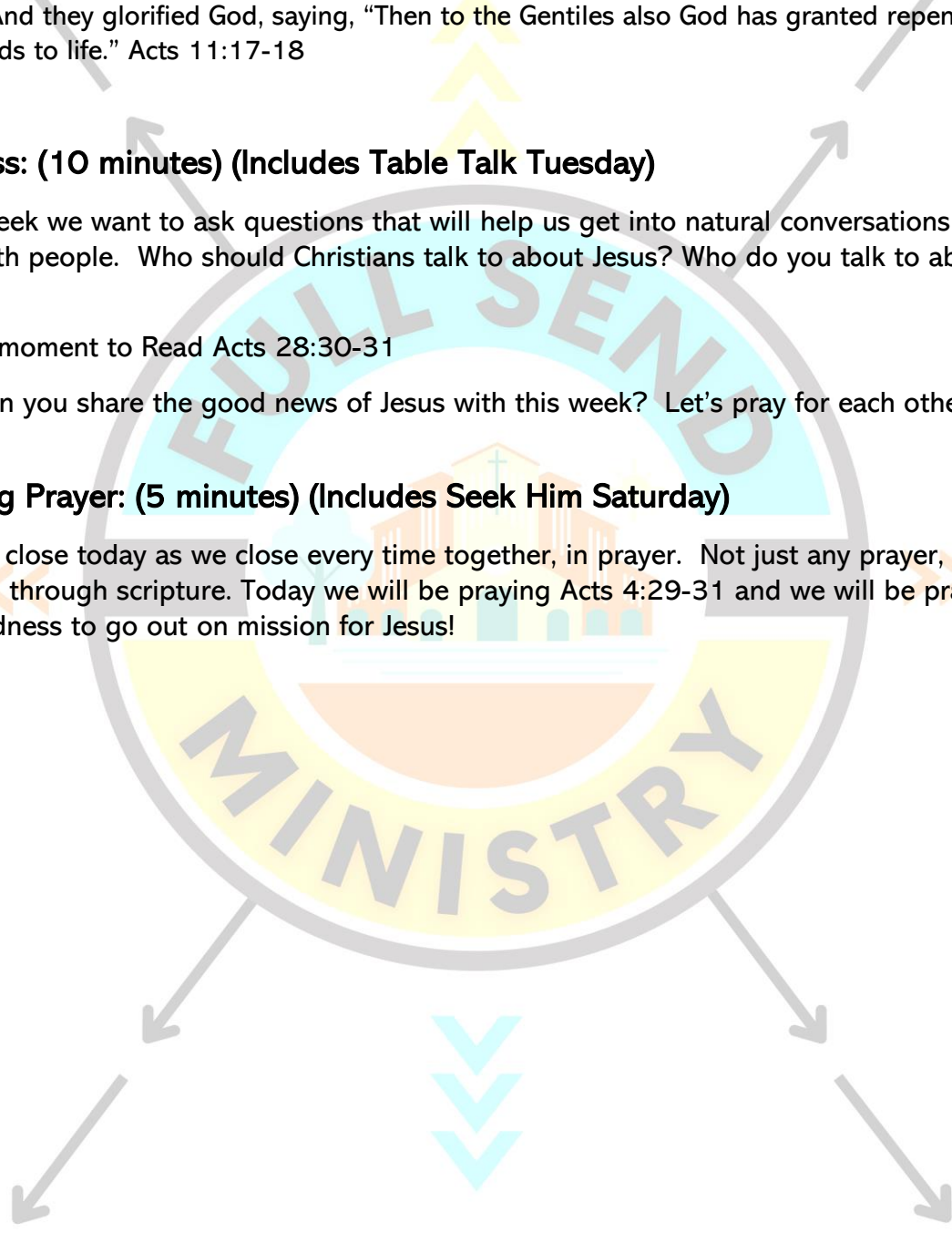
Each week we want to ask questions that will help us get into natural conversations about God with people. Who should Christians talk to about Jesus? Who do you talk to about Jesus?

**Scripture: Acts 8:1-3, 10:1-48 and 13:1-3**

**Topic: The Mission**

**Scripture Sunday:**

Read through Acts 8:1-3, 10:1-48 and 13:1-3. What do these passages say about the mission of the early church and who the gospel is for?

**Memorize Monday:**

If then God gave the same gift to them as he gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could stand in God's way?" When they heard these things they fell silent. And they glorified God, saying, "Then to the Gentiles also God has granted repentance that leads to life." Acts 11:17-18

**Table Talk Tuesday:**

Talk: Who should Christians talk to about Jesus

Text: He lived there two whole years at his own expense, and welcomed all who came to him, proclaiming the kingdom of God and teaching about the Lord Jesus Christ with all boldness and without hindrance. Acts 28:30-31

Truth: Christians are called to talk to everyone about Jesus. Can I share who He is with you today?
