Full Send Leadership - Embrace and Model

Welcome: (15 minutes)

Last week we talked about being a follower and this week we are going to talk about being a leader, but before we talk about leadership I want to hear about the people God has placed on your heart to disciple. (Take 5-7 minutes to listen as people share who they will disciple and how/when they will disciple them. It won't happen without a plan) To be a good leader we need to be a close follower of Jesus Christ. In our lives we can follow our feelings, our friends, our good intentions or God. Share a situation where you followed your friends and explain how that turned out. Share a situation where you followed your friends and how that turned out. Share a situation where you followed God and how that turned out. Have 1 or 2 people share about each situation to keep the class moving

The verse today reminds us that the people we lead will reflect what we teach them and so it's important to teach them the truth that we know as we walk closely to Jesus. Let's memorize Luke 6:40, A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone when he is fully trained will be like his teacher. Put one word on each piece of paper and after going over the verse once or twice have the group try to put the verse together one word at a time with those pieces of paper.

- How long do you think it takes to be a fully trained disciple?

Witness: (15 minutes)

Last week we talked about what do we follow when making our day to day decisions. This week I am wondering who you model your life after or who do you imitate as you live your life? Some people may want to model a celebrity or an athlete. Others want to model a family member or a friend. There are many people we look up to and many people we may want to be like, who is that in your life? Now that you have named that person can you describe why you follow them.

Let's read Matthew 4:18-19, what do you hear in these verses? Who does Jesus invite us to follow and live like? I am committing to live like Jesus, would you join me on this journey?

God has called us not just to know what we believe, but live it out. Over the last three weeks we have been challenged to pray with and for others, share our faith with others and to start a disciple multiplying relationship. If any of these have been challenges or are still challenges I want to encourage you to go for it this week. Let's keep living this life to the fullest in Jesus Christ and be FULLY SENT 100% committed to Jesus Christ without the fear of failure or worry of what might happen. God is using you to advance His kingdom on earth!

Closing Prayer: (5 minutes)

Today as we close we are going to be praying through John 21:15-17. Yes Lord I love You, Yes Lord I will feed Your lambs. Yes Lord I love You, Yes Lord I will tend Your sheep. Yes Lord I love You, Yes Lord I will feed Your sheep! Declare your love for God and for other people as you pray today.
