

Full Send Bold Vision

Welcome: (15 minutes)

Welcome back leaders! Let's start today by sharing how we loved God this week, loved others and were authentic (Take 5-7 minutes to listen as people share their experiences this week) Way to lead! I love to hear what God is doing in each and everyone of your lives each week. This is a life long action, so lets keep moving as we talk about a bold vision. God has called us to reach our Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and even the ends of the earth. Everyone needs to hear how the blood of Jesus can wash you white as snow. Witness: (15 minutes)

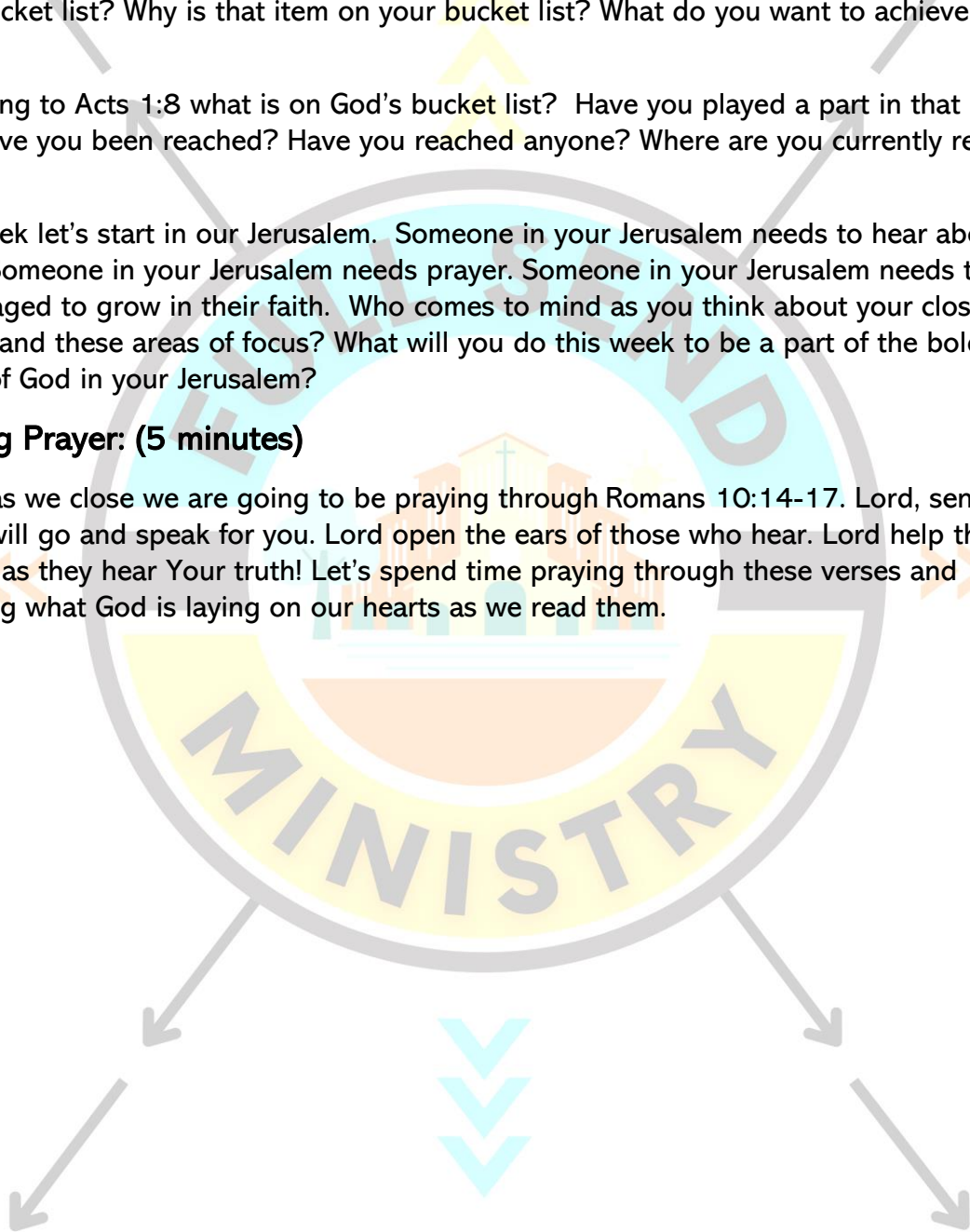
