During this month we will find out that there are two paths that we can be walking on and one is following wisdom and the other is follow folly. Once we find the path to wisdom it takes intentionality to continue walking down the road and not veer off to folly, and once we find it we can't help but share the road with others. Join us this month as we seek wisdom together in the book of Proverbs.

Each session includes (60 – 75 minutes):

- ❖ **Share Time:** An opportunity for people to share where they saw God this week. (7 minutes)
- ❖ **Connection Time:** An activity to grow in relationship with each other. (8 minutes)
- ❖ **Worship:** Songs that speak the truth of the session. (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Teaching:** A video clip that dives into the chapter. (15-20 minutes)
- ❖ **Scripture Memory:** Tools to hide the word of God in your heart. (5-7 minutes)
- ❖ **Simple Spiritual Conversation Starters:** Questions that can easily transition to spiritual conversations (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Biblical Prayer:** Prompts to pray Scripture back to God (5 minutes)

Lesson #1 Getting On The Path

What you will need for this lesson:

Setup:

- Have the song videos and teaching videos pulled up on the computer.
- Prepare the tool for memorizing scripture.
- Put a list of past scriptures on the board to go over.
- Print a copy of the daily tools for each attendee.

Curriculum Note: As you walk through each daily tool, have your group write down who or when they could use that tool this week. This curriculum is a call and an expectation of action in this world. Let's equip, empower and encourage each other to live our lives 100% committed to Jesus every day.

Welcome: (Includes Share Time and Fun Friday)

As you begin your time together talk about an animal you are afraid of. Then talk about what you do if you might have the chance of encountering that animal. How might you show your respect for the power of that animal?

Listening and singing to God is a great way to connect with Him and hear Biblical truths. Encourage your group to either listen or sing along, whatever is best for them. As they engage with each song there will be a few questions to unpack what they heard and experienced.

Witness: (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Now that we have read and studied about the beginning of wisdom, invite the group to answer the questions as they would. Then think about how others may answer the questions and how they can turn that into a spiritual conversation.

The questions of the day are: What is wisdom? Do you consider yourself wise? How did/do you become wise? Do you think following God is wise? Can I share with you how respecting God and His word is wise?

As we process these questions, we hope that each person is prepared and equipped to use these questions in normal everyday conversations throughout the week.

Let's read Proverbs 1:28-29

Truth: True wisdom is found in God and when we deny Him we will be found foolish.

May this section be an encouragement to those who hear it, and may God fill them with the hope they can have in Jesus Christ.

Closing Prayer: (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

Each week we want to teach people how to pray scripture back to God. Sometimes it is as easy as speaking the text and other times it is using the concepts of the passage to say what is going on in our lives. **Let's finish our day by praying Proverbs 1:29-33 today and pray for those who are turning away from the wisdom of God and His instruction.**

Encourage the group to come back with stories of what God did this week and how He worked through these daily tools.

This series we are going to read 6 chapters a week. You can read them all at once or read one a day for the week. As we begin our path towards wisdom read Proverbs 1-6 with me this week. What is the beginning of wisdom?
