This month in Proverbs we are going to seek wisdom and find it. During this month we will find out that there are two paths that we can be walking on and one is following wisdom and the other is follow folly. Once we find the path to wisdom it takes intentionality to continue walking down the road and not veer off to folly, and once we find it we can't help but share the road with others. Join us this month as we seek wisdom together in the book of Proverbs.

Each session includes (60 – 75 minutes):

- ❖ **Share Time:** An opportunity for people to share where they saw God this week. (7 minutes)
- ❖ **Connection Time:** An activity to grow in relationship with each other. (8 minutes)
- ❖ **Worship:** Songs that speak the truth of the session. (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Teaching:** A video clip that dives into the chapter. (15-20 minutes)
- ❖ **Scripture Memory:** Tools to hide the word of God in your heart. (5-7 minutes)
- ❖ **Simple Spiritual Conversation Starters:** Questions that can easily transition to spiritual conversations (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Biblical Prayer:** Prompts to pray Scripture back to God (5 minutes)

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Lesson #2 Staying On The Path

What you will need for this lesson:

Print off three copies of the memory verse (10 pages for each verse, about 2-3 words on a page.)

Setup:

- Have the song videos and teaching videos pulled up on the computer.
- Prepare the tool for memorizing scripture.
- Put a list of past scriptures on the board to go over.
- Print a copy of the daily tools for each attendee.

Curriculum Note: As you walk through each daily tool, have your group write down who or when they could use that tool this week. This curriculum is a call and an expectation of action in this world. Let's equip, empower and encourage each other to live our lives 100% committed to Jesus every day.

Welcome: (Includes Share Time and Fun Friday)

As you begin today have a conversation about if you have ever been on a wrong road or made a wrong turn and how that impacted your journey? Share if you have ever been on a bad path or trail that was difficult and then talk about how a clean and clear path is much easier.

At Full Send we love to celebrate what God is doing and that is why we want testimony time to be a part of every session. We believe that God has been moving throughout the week and want to celebrate with each other where we saw Him. **Before we start talking about the book of Proverbs let's share what God has been doing in our lives this week!** After a few people have shared praise God for His movement in your lives.

Worship: (Includes Tune In Thursday)

Listening and singing to God is a great way to connect with Him and hear Biblical truths. Encourage your group to either listen or sing along, whatever is best for them. As they engage with each song there will be a few questions to unpack what they heard and experienced.

Word: (Includes Scripture Sunday, Memorize Monday and Watch It Wednesday)

Before we listen to the message from Vince let's read Proverbs 9.

Today we are going to hear from Vince Godfrey about staying on the path of wisdom

Encourage people to take notes on the back of their sheet of daily tools as they listen to the teaching. **Ask them what stood out to them from the teaching or the scripture.**

Let's memorize Proverbs 8:35-36 For whoever finds me finds life and obtains favor from the Lord, but he who fails to find me injures himself; all who hate me love death." Proverbs 8:35-36

Print 3 copies of the Bible verse on sheets of paper(Should be about 8-10 sheets of paper per group. Make sure to mix up the papers before you arrive. Then hand out a pile of papers to each group and see who can unscramble the papers and put them in order first.

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Witness: (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Now that we have read and studied about staying on the path, invite the group to answer the questions as they would. Then think about how others may answer the questions and how they can turn that into a spiritual conversation.

The questions of the day are: Have you ever walked down the wrong path when you were hiking? What was the result? Have you ever walked down the wrong path in life? How did you get there? Can I share with you the way to stay on the right path?

As we process these questions, we hope that each person is prepared and equipped to use these questions in normal everyday conversations throughout the week.

Let's read Proverbs 7:4-5

Truth: There are different paths in life. One that pleases God and one that does not.

May this section be an encouragement to those who hear it, and may God fill them with the hope they can have in Jesus Christ.

Closing Prayer: (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

Each week we want to teach people how to pray scripture back to God. Sometimes it is as easy as speaking the text and other times it is using the concepts of the passage to say what is going on in our lives. **Let's finish our day by praying Proverbs 8:6-9 and give thanks to God for the wisdom and truth of His word.**

Encourage the group to come back with stories of what God did this week and how He worked through these daily tools.

Scripture: Proverbs 7-12**Topic: Staying on the Path****Scripture Sunday:**

This week we will be reading Proverbs 7-12. What are some differences between the path of wisdom and the path of folly?

Memorize Monday:

For whoever finds me finds life and obtains favor from the Lord, but he who fails to find me injures himself; all who hate me love death.” Proverbs 8:35-36

Table Talk Tuesday:

Talk: Have you ever walked down the wrong path when you were hiking? What was the result? Have you ever walked down the wrong path in life? How did you get there? Can I share with you the way to stay on the right path?

Text: Say to wisdom, “You are my sister,” and call insight your intimate friend, to keep you from the forbidden woman, from the adulteress with her smooth words. Proverbs 7:4-5
