Welcome: (15 minutes) (Includes our Fun Friday challenge)

Welcome back to the series on the book of Ruth! Ruth chapter 2 shows people meeting the needs of others. Boaz extends kindness to Ruth and the ability to glean, while Ruth is trying to extend kindness and provide for Naomi. Today I want to share a little kindness with you as we spend time sharing what God did in our lives this week.

There is nothing better than hearing what God is doing in the life of our group, so let's take time to share with each other where we saw God this week! (Each week during the welcome time we want to hear where the group saw God at work during the week. Take 5-7 minutes to share some brief stories. Make sure to end this time with praise to God and expectation for the next week)

Worship: (10 minutes) (Includes the Tune in Thursday Songs)

I love how music can express the words that we can't come up with on our own. I find that to be the same when I read the book of Psalms. Today as we listen to these two songs let's answer these questions.

- What are some of the needs we hear about in these songs?
- What do we hear of God in these songs?
- Is there someone that could benefit from these songs in your life?

Word: (20 minutes) (Includes Scripture Sunday, Memorize Monday and Watch It Wednesday)

Before we dive into some teaching on Ruth 2 let's take some time to read Ruth chapter 2.

Now we are a going to hear from Jeanette Van Genderen as she shares some thoughts on chapter 2. https://youtu.be/R3n2BSUBMag

- What does this chapter say about God?
- What does this chapter say about humanity and life?
- How does that truth of God impact our life?

As we memorize scripture today I invite you to write the whole verse out on the whiteboard and make sure you have 10-12 piece of paper. Work on three words at a time and after you have repeated them multiple times and can say them I invite you to have a member of the

group come forward and cover those words with a piece or 2 of paper. Keep doing that section by section until you can say the whole verse with it covered.

Our verse for today comes from Ruth 2:12 The Lord repay you for what you have done, and a full reward be given you by the Lord, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to take refuge! Ruth 2:12

Witness: (10 minutes) (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Each week we want to ask questions that will help us get into natural conversations about God with people. Who has provided for you in your life or who provides for you right now? Has there ever been a time where you haven't had what you NEEDED? What happened when you didn't have what you needed?

Take a moment to Read Ruth 2:9. Boaz provided safety, water and an abundance of grain for Ruth.

The truth is, that God is the one that provides all things that we need. In this passage Boaz is being the hands and feet of God and extending provision to Ruth and Naomi.

Closing Prayer: (5 minutes) (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

We will close today as we close every time together, in prayer. Not just any prayer, but praying through scripture. Today we will be praying Ruth 2:20 and explaining thanksgiving to God for His provision in our lives.

Scripture: Ruth 2 Topic: Provision

Scripture Sunday:

Read through Ruth 2 today. As you read ask yourself, what does it say about God and what does it say about humanity?

Memorize Monday:

The Lord repay you for what you have done, and a full reward be given you by the Lord, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to take refuge! Ruth 2:12

Table Talk Tuesday:

Talk: Who provides for you? Have you ever not had what you needed? What happened?

Text: Let your eyes be on the field that they are reaping, and go after them. Have I not charged the young men not to touch you? And when you are thirsty, go to the vessels and drink what the young men have drawn. Ruth 2:9

Truth: In this story Ruth was an immigrant to a foreign land and had no money. She needed to rely on someone else to provide for her and God used Boaz to provide for Naomi and Ruth.
