Over the next five weeks we are going to walk through the book of Jeremiah and answer these questions. It is our goal in this curriculum to challenge you to wake up every morning thinking about the plan God has for you, how to remain faithful to Him, how to be aware of your sin and willing to confront others in their sin. We will also learn about the future hope we have in Christ when we put our faith and trust in Him as Lord and Savior. Join us on this journey and wake up every morning standing on the firm foundation of the word of God.

Each session includes (60 – 75 minutes):

- ❖ **Share Time:** An opportunity for people to share where they saw God this week. (7 minutes)
- ❖ **Connection Time:** An activity to grow in relationship with each other. (8 minutes)
- ❖ **Worship:** Songs that speak the truth of the session. (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Teaching:** A video clip that dives into the chapter. (15-20 minutes)
- ❖ **Scripture Memory:** Tools to hide the word of God in your heart. (5-7 minutes)
- ❖ **Simple Spiritual Conversation Starters:** Questions that can easily transition to spiritual conversations (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Biblical Prayer:** Prompts to pray Scripture back to God (5 minutes)

Lesson #3: Confront Lies

What you will need for this lesson:

Obstacle course supplies

Setup:

- Have the song videos and teaching videos pulled up on the computer.
- Prepare the tool for memorizing scripture.
- Put a list of past scriptures on the board to go over.
- Print a copy of the daily tools for each attendee.

Curriculum Note: As you walk through each daily tool have your group write down who or when they could use that tool this week. This curriculum is a call and an expectation of action in this world. Let's equip, empower and encourage each other to live our lives 100% committed to Jesus every day.

Welcome: (Includes Share Time and Fun Friday)

Set up a short obstacle course ahead of time. Have someone try it blindfolded without any help. Anytime they hit something they need to start over. After a few attempts have some lead them verbally through. Talk about how "confronting" others can actually be helpful.

At Full Send we love to celebrate what God is doing and that is why we want testimony time to be a part of every time we get together. We believe that God has been moving throughout the week and want to celebrate with each other where we saw Him. **Before we start talking about the book of Jeremiah let's share what God has been doing in our lives this week!** After a few people have shared praise God for His movement in your lives.

Worship: (Includes Tune In Thursday)

Listening and singing to God is a great way to connect with Him and hear Biblical truths. Encourage your group to either listen or sing along, whatever is best for them. As they engage with each song there will be a few questions to unpack what they heard and experienced.

Word: (Includes Scripture Sunday, Memorize Monday and Watch It Wednesday)

Before we listen to the message from Jeremy Jeremiah 23:9-32

Today we are going to hear from Jeremy Van Genderen as he talks confronting the lies others believe <https://youtu.be/cykMiM6tpI0>

Encourage people to take notes on the back of their sheet of daily tools as they listen to the teaching. Ask them what stood out to them from the teaching.

Let's memorize Jeremiah 25:7 Yet you have not listened to me, declares the Lord, that you might provoke me to anger with the work of your hands to your own harm.

Today we are going to memorize in partners. Split into groups of two and have the partners alternate saying words/phrases. For example, person 1 says yet, person 2 says you, person 1 says have, person 2 says not. After a few minutes the groups should have a pretty good handle on it.

Witness: (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Now that we have read and studied about confrontation, challenge the group to answer the questions as they would. Then think about how others may answer the questions and how they can turn that into a spiritual conversation.

The questions of the day are: How would you like someone to talk to you about something they disagree with you about? How do you normally respond if someone confronts you? I love you and because I love you let's talk about . . .

As we process these questions, we hope that each person is prepared and equipped to use these questions in normal everyday conversations throughout the week.

Let's read Jeremiah 23:16

Listen to the Truth of God and now the world.

May this section be an encouragement to those who hear it, and may God fill them with the hope they can have in Jesus Christ.

Closing Prayer: (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

Each week we want to teach people how to pray scripture back to God. Sometimes it is as easy as speaking the text and other times it is using the concepts of the passage to say what is going on in our lives. **Let's finish our day by praying through Jeremiah 17:5-8 and proclaim to God your trust in Him.**

Encourage the group to come back with stories of what God did this week and how He worked through these daily tools.

Scripture: Jeremiah 11-29

Topic: Confront Lies

Scripture Sunday:

Join me today in reading Jeremiah chapters 11-29. List the ways that Jeremiah confronted the people of Judah and what their response was.

Memorize Monday:

Yet you have not listened to me, declares the Lord, that you might provoke me to anger with the work of your hands to your own harm. Jeremiah 25:7

Table Talk Tuesday:

Talk: How would you like someone to talk to you about something they disagree with you about? How do you normally respond if someone confronts you? I love you and because I love you let's talk about . . .

Text: Thus says the Lord of hosts: "Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you, filling you with vain hopes. They speak visions of their own minds, not from the mouth of the Lord. Jeremiah 23:16

Truth: Listen to the truth of God and not the lies of the world.

Fun Friday:

Today I want you to make an obstacle course. Then blindfold someone and have them go through it. If they hit an obstacle they must go back to the beginning. Ask, how did it feel when you were confronted with an obstacle? Then have someone verbally help them through the course to avoid the obstacles.

Seek Him Saturday:

Pray through Jeremiah 17:5-8 and proclaim to God your trust in Him.
