This month we are going to be studying the book of Ezekiel. As we look through this prophetic book we are going to look at the values of worship, discipleship, fellowship and service. We will learn of the successes and failures of the past, be challenged to genuinely look at our current situation and then look at how God invites us to walk in these values going forward. I pray that our time in Ezekiel will transform us as believers to walk faithfully in worship, discipleship, fellowship and service.

Each session includes (60 – 75 minutes):

- ❖ **Share Time:** An opportunity for people to share where they saw God this week. (7 minutes)
- ❖ **Connection Time:** An activity to grow in relationship with each other. (8 minutes)
- ❖ **Worship:** Songs that speak the truth of the session. (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Teaching:** A video clip that dives into the chapter. (15-20 minutes)
- ❖ **Scripture Memory:** Tools to hide the word of God in your heart. (5-7 minutes)
- ❖ **Simple Spiritual Conversation Starters:** Questions that can easily transition to spiritual conversations (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Biblical Prayer:** Prompts to pray Scripture back to God (5 minutes)

What you will need for this lesson:

Setup:

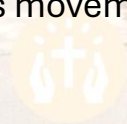
- Have the song videos and teaching videos pulled up on the computer.
- Prepare the tool for memorizing scripture.
- Put a list of past scriptures on the board to go over.
- Print a copy of the daily tools for each attendee.

Welcome: (Includes Share Time and Fun Friday)

Brainstorm with your group different ways of serving others this week. Once you have come up with some ideas, then brainstorm people each person could invite to join them on this service project.

Before we listen to the message from Brad let's read Ezekiel 34

Today we are going to hear from Brad Van Genderen about Service

Encourage people to take notes on the back of their sheet of daily tools as they listen to the teaching. **Ask them what stood out to them from the teaching or the scripture.**

Let's memorize Ezekiel 11:19-20 And I will give them one heart, and a new spirit I will put within them. I will remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh, that they may walk in my statutes and keep my rules and obey them. And they shall be my people, and I will be their God.

Let's start by listening to this verse in song form.

Today we are going to memorize this verse by breaking into pairs and then alternating words. Person #1 says AND, Person #2 says I, Person #1 says WILL, Person #2 says GIVE and so on through the verse. Once you can do the whole verse 1 word at a time then move to saying phrases at a time.

Witness: (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Now that we have read and studied about service, invite the group to answer the questions as they would. Then think about how others may answer the questions and how they can turn that into a spiritual conversation.

The questions of the day are: How is your day going? Are you struggling with anything? Could I help in any way? Can I pray for you and share a Bible verse with you?

As we process these questions, we hope that each person is prepared and equipped to use these questions in normal everyday conversations throughout the week.

Let's read Ezekiel 34:16

Truth: God desires to provide the best for us. We have the opportunity to join Him in doing this.

May this section be an encouragement to those who hear it, and may God fill them with the hope they can have in Jesus Christ.

Closing Prayer: (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

Each week we want to teach people how to pray scripture back to God. Sometimes it is as easy as speaking the text and other times it is using the concepts of the passage to say what is going on in our lives. **Let's finish our day by praying Ezekiel 34:11-16 and ask God to meet you where you are at, provide what you need and then ask how you can serve others.**

Encourage the group to come back with stories of what God did this week and how He worked through these daily tools.

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Scripture: Ezekiel 34**Topic: Service****Scripture Sunday:**

As we finish up Ezekiel take some time today to read Ezekiel 34 and write down how we are encouraged to serve others.

Memorize Monday:

And I will give them one heart, and a new spirit I will put within them. I will remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh, that they may walk in my statutes and keep my rules and obey them. And they shall be my people, and I will be their God. Ezekiel 11:19-20
