

Scripture Haggai 2 Topic: Surrender and Everything is God's

Memorize Monday:

'The silver is mine and the gold is mine,' declares the Lord Almighty. Haggai 2:8

Table Talk Tuesday:

Talk: What does the good life look like?

Text: Haggai 2:18-19 Consider from this day onward, from the twenty-fourth day of the ninth month. Since the day that the foundation of the LORD's temple was laid, consider: Is the seed yet in the barn? Indeed, the vine, the fig tree, the pomegranate, and the olive tree have yielded nothing. But from this day on I will bless you."

When did God bless them?

Truth: Blessing comes as you surrender your time, talents and treasures to God.
