Welcome: (15 minutes) (Includes our Fun Friday challenge)

Welcome to the series on the book of Acts! The early church gathered together and spent time in fellowship. That fellowship consisted of talking about their common interest in God and what He had been doing in their life. Let's spend some time in fellowship this morning and share what God is doing. (Each week during the welcome time we want to hear where the group saw God at work during the week. Take 5-7 minutes to share some brief stories. Make sure to end this time with praise to God and expectation for the next week)

The Holy Spirit gave the ability to speak in different languages to the early disciples. Today we are going to learn John 3:16 in different languages. Here are a few options

Hawaii Pidgin - "God wen get so plenny love an aloha fo da peopo inside da world, dat he wen send me, his one an ony Boy, so dat everybody dat trus me no get cut off from God, but get da real kine life dat stay to da max foeva.

Spanish - Dios amó tanto al mundo, que dio a su único Hijo, para que todo el que cree en él no se pierda, sino tenga vida eterna.

Worship: (10 minutes) (Includes the Tune in Thursday Songs)

We are going to take a few minutes to listen to two songs and as you listen I want you to answer these questions.

- What do these songs say about the Holy Spirit?
- What are we asking from the Holy Spirit?
- Is there someone that could benefit from these songs in your life?

Word: (20 minutes) (Includes Scripture Sunday, Memorize Monday and Watch It Wednesday)

Before we dive into some teaching on Acts lets read Acts 1:8, 2:1-13 and 8:26-40 today.

As we memorize scripture today I encourage you to write the verse on a white board. Have some papers to cover up words as you memorize them.

Witness: (10 minutes) (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Each week we want to ask questions that will help us get into natural conversations about God with people. Who do you listen to, to decide what to do?

Take a moment to Read Acts 8:26-27

The Holy Spirit guides us and tells us the truth of the word of God. The Holy Spirit also gives us power to live for Jesus in all we do.

Closing Prayer: (5 minutes) (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

We will close today as we close every time together, in prayer. Not just any prayer, but praying through scripture. Today we will be praying Acts 8:35 and asking God to open our mouth to explain His Scripture to those around us.



Scripture: Acts 1:8, 2:1-13, and 8:26-40 Topic: Holy Spirit

Scripture Sunday:

Read through Acts 1:8, 2:1-13 and 8:26-40 this week and discuss what these verses say about the Holy Spirit and its impact on us.

Memorize Monday:

And the Spirit said to Philip, "Go over and join this chariot." So Philip ran to him and heard him reading Isaiah the prophet and asked, "Do you understand what you are reading?" Acts 9:29-30

Table Talk Tuesday:

Talk: How do you make decisions? Who do you listen to?

Text: Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, "Rise and go toward the south[a] to the road that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." This is a desert place. And he rose and went. And there was an Ethiopian, a eunuch, a court official of Candace, queen of the Ethiopians, who was in charge of all her treasure. He had come to Jerusalem to worship Acts 8:26-27

Truth: The Holy Spirit leads us to Jesus and to live our lives for Jesus. He helps us know what to do and gives us the power to do it.
