As we engage with those we do not agree with it is important to stand on and speak from truth and not on what we assume to be true. Finally, this month the question will be asked, whom will you serve, God or self? Join us this month as we learn how to fight our everyday battles

Each session includes (60 – 75 minutes):

- ❖ **Share Time:** An opportunity for people to share where they saw God this week. (7 minutes)
- ❖ **Connection Time:** An activity to grow in relationship with each other. (8 minutes)
- ❖ **Worship:** Songs that speak the truth of the session. (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Teaching:** A video clip that dives into the chapter. (15-20 minutes)
- ❖ **Scripture Memory:** Tools to hide the word of God in your heart. (5-7 minutes)
- ❖ **Simple Spiritual Conversation Starters:** Questions that can easily transition to spiritual conversations (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Biblical Prayer:** Prompts to pray Scripture back to God (5 minutes)

Lesson #2: Remember What God Has Done

What you will need for this lesson:

Memory or trivia game

Printed out copies of the Bible Verse

Setup:

- Have the song videos and teaching videos pulled up on the computer.
- Prepare the tool for memorizing scripture.
- Put a list of past scriptures on the board to go over.
- Print a copy of the daily tools for each attendee.

Curriculum Note: As you walk through each daily tool, have your group write down who or when they could use that tool this week. This curriculum is a call and an expectation of action in this world. Let's equip, empower and encourage each other to live our lives 100% committed to Jesus every day.

Welcome: (Includes Share Time and Fun Friday)

Bring a trivia or memory game to share with the group. See how many things they can remember as they answer questions or find matches.

Before we listen to the message from Zach let's read Joshua 2

Today we are going to hear from Zach Van Genderen on remembering.

Encourage people to take notes on the back of their sheet of daily tools as they listen to the teaching. **Ask them what stood out to them from the teaching or the scripture.**

Let's memorize Joshua 4:21-22 And he said to the people of Israel, "When your children ask their fathers in times to come, 'What do these stones mean?' then you shall let your children know, 'Israel passed over this Jordan on dry ground.'"

Today you will divide into groups of 2 or 3 and be handed some papers that have the words to this Bible verse on them. It is your job to put them in order the fastest.

Witness: (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Now that we have read and studied about remember what God has done challenge the group to answer the questions as they would. Then think about how others may answer the questions and how they can turn that into a spiritual conversation.

The questions of the day are: Do you find it easy or hard to remember things? What is something that you forgot that you were supposed to remember? Is there anything that you can remember about God and what He has done? Can I share with you what I remember of God and what He has done?

As we process these questions, we hope that each person is prepared and equipped to use these questions in normal everyday conversations throughout the week.

Let's read Joshua 3:16-17

Truth: I know God can do all things.

May this section be an encouragement to those who hear it, and may God fill them with the hope they can have in Jesus Christ.

Closing Prayer: (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

Each week we want to teach people how to pray scripture back to God. Sometimes it is as easy as speaking the text and other times it is using the concepts of the passage to say what is going on in our lives. **Let's finish our day by Pray Joshua 4:24 and declare the might and power of God!**

Encourage the group to come back with stories of what God did this week and how He worked through these daily tools.

Scripture: Joshua 2-4

Topic: Remember What God Has Done

Scripture Sunday:

Read Joshua 2-4 today and discuss some of the things that were to be remembered.

Memorize Monday:

And he said to the people of Israel, "When your children ask their fathers in times to come, 'What do these stones mean?' then you shall let your children know, 'Israel passed over this Jordan on dry ground.'" Joshua 4:21-22

Table Talk Tuesday:
