Join us on this journey and wake up every morning standing on the firm foundation of the word of God.

Each session includes (60 - 75 minutes):

- Share Time: An opportunity for people to share where they saw God this week. (7 minutes)
- Connection Time: An activity to grow in relationship with each other. (8 minutes)
- ❖ Worship: Songs that speak the truth of the session. (10-15 minutes)
- * Teaching: A video clip that dives into the chapter. (15-20 minutes)
- Scripture Memory: Tools to hide the word of God in your heart. (5-7 minutes)
- Simple Spiritual Conversation Starters: Questions that can easily transition to spiritual conversations (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ Biblical Prayer: Prompts to pray Scripture back to God (5 minutes)

What you will need for this lesson:

Mystery Stories

Setup:

- Have the song videos and teaching videos pulled up on the computer.
- Prepare the tool for memorizing scripture.
- Put a list of past scriptures on the board to go over.
- Print a copy of the daily tools for each attendee.

Curriculum Note: As you walk through each daily tool have your group write down who or when they could use that tool this week. This curriculum is a call and an expectation of action in this world. Let's equip, empower and encourage each other to live our lives 100% committed to Jesus every day.

Jeremiah: In the Mo(u)rning Week 2: Be Aware of Sin

Worship: (Includes Tune In Thursday)

Listening and singing to God is a great way to connect with Him and hear Biblical truths. Encourage your group to either listen or sing along, whatever is best for them. As they engage with each song there will be a few questions to unpack what they heard and experienced.

Word: (Includes Scripture Sunday, Memorize Monday and Watch It Wednesday)

Before we listen to the message from Brad let's read Jeremiah 7:1-20

Today we are going to hear from Brad Van Genderen as he talks about dealing with our sin https://youtu.be/hofH7rUTjCY

Encourage people to take notes on the back of their sheet of daily tools as they listen to the teaching. Ask them what stood out to them from the teaching.

Let's memorize Jeremiah 8:6 I have paid attention and listened, but they have not spoken rightly; no man relents of his evil, saying, 'What have I done?' Everyone turns to his own course, like a horse plunging headlong into battle.

Today I encourage you to memorize this verse by listening to the Youtube video multiple times. By the third time the group should be able to sing along.

Witness: (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)

Now that we have read and studied about sin, challenge the group to answer the questions as they would. Then think about how others may answer the questions and how they can turn that into a spiritual conversation.

The questions of the day are: Would you describe yourself as aware or oblivious? Close your eyes, what color of shirt are you wearing? What color of shirt am I wearing? When it comes to making mistakes are you aware or oblivious? What sin do you struggle with?

As we process these questions, we hope that each person is prepared and equipped to use these questions in normal everyday conversations throughout the week.

Let's read Jeremiah 7:9-10

God is aware of all things, nothing is hidden from Him.

May this section be an encouragement to those who hear it, and may God fill them with the hope they can have in Jesus Christ.

Closing Prayer: (Includes Seek Him Saturday)

Each week we want to teach people how to pray scripture back to God. Sometimes it is as easy as speaking the text and other times it is using the concepts of the passage to say what is going on in our lives. Let's finish our day by praying through Jeremiah 4:1-4 and be aware of your sin. If we confess Jesus is faithful to forgive.

Encourage the group to come back with stories of what God did this week and how He worked through these daily tools.

Scripture: Jeremiah 2-10 Topic: Be Aware of Sin

Scripture Sunday:

Join me today in reading Jeremiah chapters 2-10. What sin were the Israelites struggling with? What sin do you struggle with?

Memorize Monday:

I have paid attention and listened, but they have not spoken rightly; no man relents of his evil, saying, 'What have I done?' Everyone turns to his own course, like a horse plunging headlong into battle. Jeremiah 8:6

Table Talk Tuesday:

Text: Will you steal, murder, commit adultery, swear falsely, make offerings to Baal, and go after other gods that you have not known, and then come and stand before me in this house, which is called by my name, and say, 'We are delivered!'—only to go on doing all these abominations? Jeremiah 7:9-10

Truth: God is aware of every thought, action, and word we do and say.
