

Full Send Relational Evangelism

Welcome: (15 minutes)

Welcome back to week #2 of our gospel advancing series. Let's take a moment and share how God led us to use the tools this week for His glory and the outcome that happened. (Take 5-7 minutes for people to share a few testimonies) As we talk about relational evangelism today we are going to start with a trivia challenge. Have any of you ever went to a trivia night? Because of time we will only have 1 round about Jesus, but when you do it later this week I encourage you to have multiple rounds with Jesus being one of them. (10 Trivia questions about Jesus are included at the end)

Worship: (10 minutes)

Our two songs today focus on our responsibility to share the good news of Jesus and the fact that God is working through us to do that. God is always on the move and is inviting us into action as well.

As we listen to these songs today I want you to think about a few things

What are these songs saying about sharing Jesus with others?

What are these songs saying about God?

Word: (15 minutes)

Jeremy Van Genderen is going to give us a short message about relational evangelism. As you are listening to this message I want you to think about what sticks out to you and what challenges you with this topic. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OtDDt00ONec>

This week we are going to put into memory Romans 10:14 We will cover 1 question at a time and as we memorize this verse I want us also to discuss briefly for a minute or two how we would answer that question. **Use whatever tool works best for you and your group to memorize scripture. You can write it question by question on a white board or have each question printed out. Either way I would encourage some sort of visual representation and show them how this verse flows off of the question before it.**

Witness: (15 minutes)

It's time to practice our communication with other people. The reason we have this section is because people find it so hard to bring up spiritual conversations and so we are going to work on this together here and feel equipped and empowered to use it this week with our friends, family and co-workers. This week we are going to jump right to Jesus since we are talking about sharing Him with others.

Who is Jesus? Do you have a relationship with Him/

- This question sets the base of understanding and will help you know where they are at in faith.

Can I tell you about Him?

- What is your testimony? What are the important parts of the message of salvation that you need to share? **Make Sure everyone is comfortable talking about sin and redemption. We sin and have a consequence on us. Jesus took on that consequence for us. We now have life with Him.**

After you share ask if there is anything keeping them from accepting Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. If they have questions try to answer them and point them to Jesus. Take a moment to admire something about where they are at in their faith and then be genuine and tell them that you believe in Jesus because you need Him and what He did. Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 and ask what they heard in those verses. This will just reiterate the gospel you already shared.

Closing Prayer: (5 minutes)

As we close in prayer today I invite you to open up to 2 Corinthians 3:2-3. As we pray I invite you to look over those verses and pray them in your own words. For example. Lord I know that the truth of the gospel is written on my heart and I pray that you will help me to have it written on every action I take and every word I say.

#2 How old was Jesus when He first taught in the temple? **Twelve Luke 2:42-47**

#4 What three temptations did Satan give to Jesus? **Turn Stones to bread, prove that He was invincible and worship Satan for control over the kingdom of the world Matthew 4:8-9**
Lust of the eyes, Lust of the flesh and the pride of life.

#5 What was the first recorded miracle of Jesus? **Water into Wine John 2:1-11**

#6 What was Jesus doing when the disciples were scared in the storm? **Sleeping mark 4:35-41**

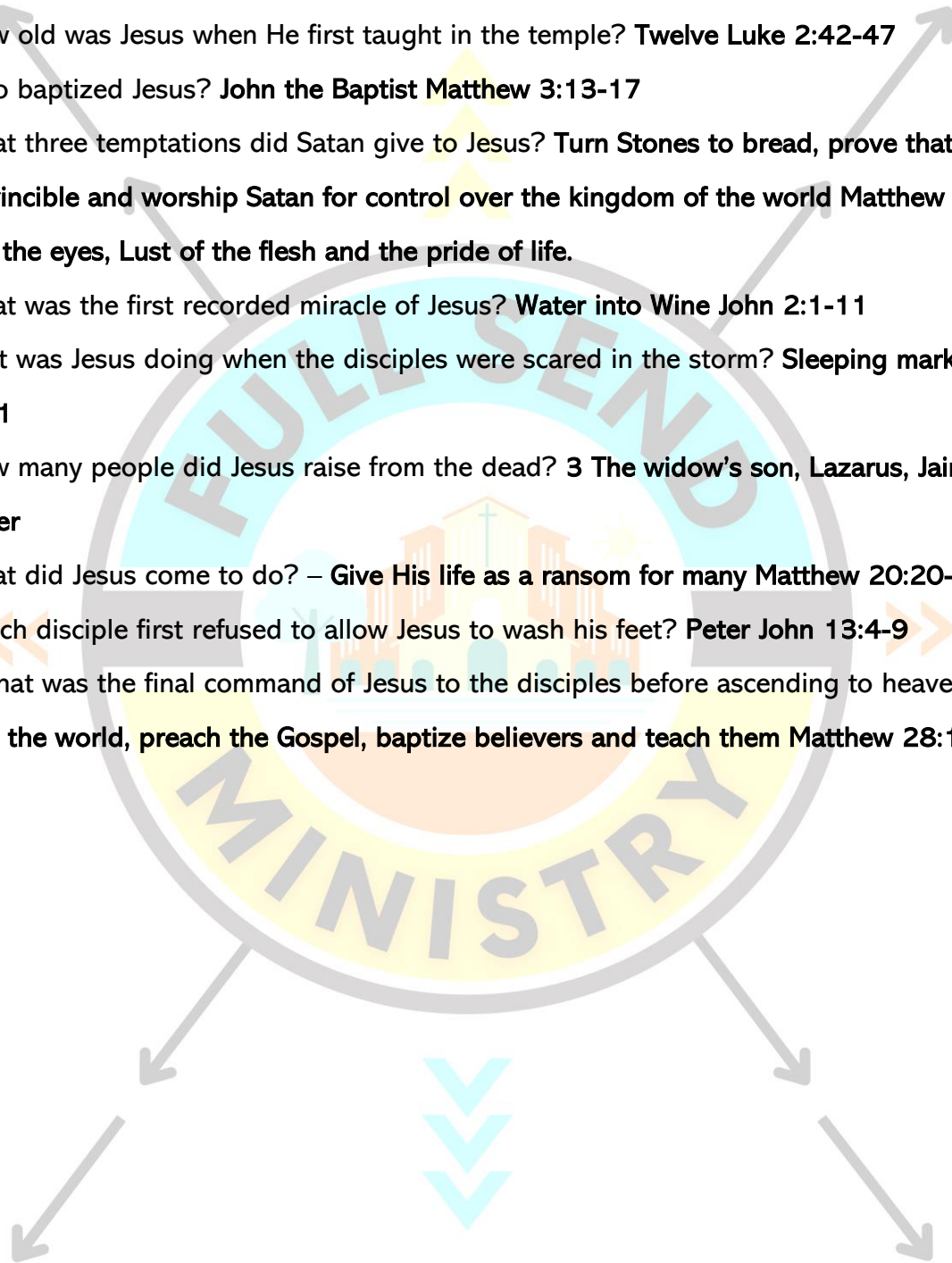
#7 How many people did Jesus raise from the dead? **3 The widow's son, Lazarus, Jairus' daughter**

#8 What did Jesus come to do? – **Give His life as a ransom for many Matthew 20:20-28**

#9 Which disciple first refused to allow Jesus to wash his feet? **Peter John 13:4-9**

#10 What was the final command of Jesus to the disciples before ascending to heaven?

Go into the world, preach the Gospel, baptize believers and teach them Matthew 28:19-20

Table Talk Tuesday:

Talk: Who is Jesus? Do you know Him? Can I tell you about Him?

Text: For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, 1 Corinthians 15:3-4

Truth: Jesus lived a perfect life, died a sacrificial death and came back to life to pay the punishment of your sin!
