- ❖ **Simple Spiritual Conversation Starters:** Questions that can easily transition to spiritual conversations (10-15 minutes)
- ❖ **Biblical Prayer:** Prompts to pray Scripture back to God (5 minutes)

## Lesson #3 Preparing for the end: Repent!

What you will need for this lesson:

Hot and Cold Food

Setup:

- Have the worship videos and teaching videos pulled up on the computer.
- Prepare the tool for memorizing scripture.
- Put a list of past scriptures on the board to go over.
- Print a copy of the daily tools for each attendee.

### Welcome: (Includes Share Time and Fun Friday)

I invite you to provide some food for your group today. Bring something hot and something cold and start the conversation about why you think things hot or cold and what the problem with lukewarm is. You can continue to the discussion about what God has done as you eat.

At Full Send we love to celebrate what God is doing and that is why we want testimony time to be a part of every time we get together. We believe that God has been moving throughout the week and want to celebrate with each other where we saw Him. **Before we start talking about Revelation let's share what God has been doing in our lives this week!** After a few people have shared praise God for His movement in your lives.

### Worship: (Includes Tune In Thursday)

Listening and singing to God is a great way to connect with Him and hear Biblical truths. Encourage your group to either listen or sing along, whatever is best for them. As they engage with each song there will be a few questions to unpack what they heard and experienced.

### Word: (Includes Scripture Sunday, Memorize Monday and Watch It Wednesday)

**Before we listen to the message from Brad on Focusing on what the church needs to repent of before the end let's read about the two churches from Revelation 3:1-6 and 14-22**

**Today we are going to hear from Brad Van Genderen as he helps us focus on how to check out spiritual temperature.** <https://youtu.be/EeAnyzDO1Qk>

Encourage people to take notes on the back of their sheet of daily tools as they listen to the teaching. Ask them what stood out to them from the teaching.

**Let's memorize Revelation 3:19-20. Get into partners and alternate saying the words of the verse. Do this 4-5 times and then see if you can say the verse together. Finish by listening to the song.**

**Witness: (Includes Table Talk Tuesday)**

Now that we have read and studied about preparing for the end by repenting of what is wrong we want to be able to apply this truth to our lives. Challenge the group to answer the questions as they would, then think about how others may answer the question and how they can turn that into a spiritual conversation.

**The questions of the day are What is something that you like to eat that is cold, hot. Is there anything you like to eat that is lukewarm? What does it mean to be hot, cold, lukewarm in your faith?**

As we process through these questions we hope that each person is prepared and equipped to use these questions in normal everyday conversations throughout the week.

**Let's read Revelation 3:15-16**

**What is keeping you from being all in for God today? It's time to Full Send in your faith and stop being lukewarm for God.**

May this section be an encouragement to those who hear it and may the benefits of seeking God be clear!

**Closing Prayer: (Includes Seek Him Saturday)**

Each week we want to teach people how to pray scripture back to God. Sometimes it is as easy as speaking the text and other times it is using the concepts of the passage to speak what is going on in our lives. **Let's finish our day by praying through Revelation 3:1-3. Ask God to show you where you are dead and ask for the Spirit to wake you up!**

Encourage the group to come back with stories of what God did this week and how He worked through these daily tools.

**Scripture: Revelation 3:1-6 and 14-22**

**Topic: The End**

**Scripture Sunday:**

As we dive into Revelation read with me about the churches of Sardis and Laodicea from Revelation 3:1-6 and 14-22. What was God's message to his people and what does that mean for us today?

**Memorize Monday:**

Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent. Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. Revelation 3:19-20

**Table Talk Tuesday:**

Talk: What is something that you like to eat that is cold, hot. Is there anything you like to eat that is lukewarm?

Text: "I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot! So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth. Revelation 3:15-16

Truth: God wants you to be all in for Him. What do you need to repent of today?

**Fun Friday:**

Let's make some food tonight. Invite friends over and invite some to bring hot food and others to bring cold food. Center your discussion around why they like hot or cold food and what it looks like to be hot, cold and lukewarm in faith. Invite to repent and become hot!

**Seek Him Saturday:**

Pray Revelation 3:1-3. Ask God to show you where you are dead and ask for the Spirit to wake you up!
