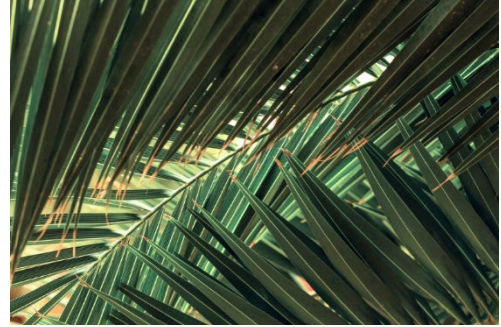

**People:** **We come, ready to feel the passion of Christ.**


**Leader:** Lord God, thank you for sending your precious son Jesus to bear the burden of our sins and secure for us a place in your Perfect Garden.






