Our Young Heroes have been here all week with Professor Rev, Super Meer, and our Hero Group Leaders. They learned stories about several people who were Heroes for God. Here are the Bible stories that we concentrated on through the week:

John 1:35-51 – Jesus builds the team. When Jesus started his ministry, the first thing he did was build a team. Jesus asked 12 disciples to follow him. They might not have seemed like heroes at the time, but Jesus would teach them how to make a great difference in the world. God can use any of us to do great things!

Exodus 1:8–2:10 – *Heroes are called to help others.* When Moses was a baby, his family thought he was in danger. To save him from danger, his mother put him in a basket and put him in the Nile River. Fortunately, there were heroic women who took him home and kept him safe.

Exodus 17 – *Heroes are called to work together*. Moses led the Israelites to freedom but they were still in some danger. One day the Israelites were being attacked. Moses learned that if he could keep his arms up, the Israelites would be protected. So, Moses tried to keep his arms up, but after a while, Moses' arms became too tired. So, two men came to help Moses. They held his arms up for him, and the Israelites were saved!

Matthew 2:1-12 – *Heroes are called to listen to God.* The magi are a part of the Christmas story. They saw a star in the sky. They knew a lot about the stars, and they knew a lot about the scriptures. They believed the new, bright star was a sign that God was doing something special! So, they listened to God. They followed that star to Bethlehem, where they found baby Jesus and his parents, Mary and Joseph.

Acts 9:1-25 – *Heroes are called to show grace.* Grace is how God forgives us even when we don't deserve it. And since God forgives us, we should forgive others.
