This Week's Bible Stories



Genesis 28 - Trust God to Go with Us.

Jacob went on a very long 500-mile journey – and he had to walk the entire way! He became very tired, so he had to sleep with his head on a rock. He had a great dream about stairs that led straight to Heaven. He saw angels and he even saw God! When Jacob woke up, he wasn't tired anymore. He was excited because God gave him a great promise, but he never would have heard that promise if he didn't take time to rest.

Ruth 1 – Trust God to Lead the Way.

There was a woman named Naomi who left her home in Bethlehem because there wasn't enough food there. She, and her husband and sons, moved to a place called Moab. While they were there, her husband and sons died. The only good news then was that Bethlehem finally had enough food again, so Naomi

decided to go back home to Bethlehem. She was going to go all alone, but her son's wife, Ruth, didn't want her to go alone. Ruth promised that wherever Naomi went, she would go with her.
