There is nothing more important or of greater value in our lives than our <u>faith.</u>

Scripture: <u>Hebrews 11:1-6; 12:1-2a</u> (ESV)

Faith is used in two ways as it pertains to the life of a believer:

1. Our <u>relationship</u> with God.

2. What we <u>believe about</u> God.

Our faith *IN* God is what connects us *TO* God.

Four Faith Connections

1. We are <u>saved</u> by grace, through faith.

Scripture: <u>Ephesians 2:8-9</u>

<u>Grace</u> is the unmerited favor of God that is undeserved and unearned.

Faith is our <u>response</u> to God.

2. We are <u>made right</u> with God through faith.

Scripture: <u>Romans 1:16-17</u>

3. We <u>live out our lives</u> through faith.

Scripture: 2. Corinthians 5:7

4. We both <u>believe</u> and <u>receive</u> by faith!

• We believe for and receive <u>healing</u> by faith.

Scripture: Matthew 8:13; Mark 5:34

• We believe for and receive <u>deliverance</u> by faith.

Scripture: Mark 9:23-25

Since there is nothing more important or of greater value in our lives than our faith, it is not only reasonable, but biblical to realize that it (our faith) will be <u>attacked and tested.</u>

1. In the <u>garden</u>

Scripture: Genesis 3:1-7

The enemies plan to attack our faith includes:

2. In the <u>desert</u>

A. Luke 4:1-13

The enemies plan to attack our faith includes:

A. Temptation and testing B. Distraction C. Doubt D. Deception E. Destruction

Scripture: Romans 10:17; Psalm 119:11

Our walk with God is strengthened more in the <u>trying times</u> rather than the <u>triumphant ones</u>.

Let the truth God speaks <u>to you</u> override the enemies lies <u>about</u> <u>you!</u>

3. In the garden.

Sometimes faith isn't about exiting, it's about enduring.

4. In the <u>unknown</u>

Scripture: Genesis 12:1-5

God always wants to stretch your faith in order for us to grow; otherwise, we would likely be comfortable staying where we are!

There is a <u>blessing</u> in the unknown!

The way of faith isn't void of <u>trials and tribulations</u>. Faith that isn't <u>tried</u> is a faith that never <u>matures</u>.

You grow in pain, not pleasure!
