The Gospel of Saint Matthew 24:3-14 - Signs of the End of the Age 3 As he sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?" 4 And Jesus answered them, "See that no one leads you astray. 5 For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and they will lead many astray. 6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not

yet. 7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places. 8 All these are but the beginning of the birth pains. 9 "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and put you to death, and you will be hated by all nations for my name's sake. 10 And then many will fall away and betray one another and hate one another. 11 And many false Prophets will arise and lead many astray. 12 And because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold. 13 But the one who endures to the end will be saved.14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come." - You may be seated...

When the Lord was speaking to the Prophet Hosea, the Prophet records the following statement in Hosea 4:6, "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge."

In 1 Chronicles 12:32, the text records as thus, "Of Issachar, men who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do, 200 chiefs, and their kinsmen under their command." Why does First Chronicles record this verse in this manner?

Because these men were adept enough, discerning enough, and aware of their current climate to know that something needed to change and go in a different direction. And as the Sons of Issachar, we must, as the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ, be able to discern the times in which we live! Which interprets to mean that we need to know our Bible!

Not everything that we see in the world around us is as it seems...

The sons of Issachar had an understanding of the times in which they lived and it helped them know what the future held and how to prepare for when the future became the present.

In Matthew 16:1-3, the text records, "And the Pharisees and Sadducees came, and to test him they asked him to show them a sign from heaven. He answered them, "When it is evening, you say, 'it will be fair weather, for the sky is red.' And in the morning, 'it will be stormy today, for the sky is red and threatening.' You know how to interpret the appearance of the sky, but you cannot interpret the signs of the times."

Jesus points out in Matthew 16, that the ones who claimed to be the most educated were in fact the most ignorant when it came to discerning Prophetic seasons. They could discern the weather but they could not, in all of their Biblical learning, discern the Prophetic season in which they lived on God's Prophetic timeline in the Earth! They could not "interpret the signs of the times."

And in this current time in which we live, there is a lot of talk about the end times and the last days because people are scared. They are scared about the presidential elections, they are scared socially, they are scared politically, economically and financially.

And it is because of these fears that Bible Prophecy exists; it gives us insight of what is to come in so that we can prepare; mentally, physically, emotionally and spiritually for what is to come in the Earth as the end of the age approaches; Bible Prophecy is meant to provide encouragement and insight for the Believer.

The Bible says in the Book of Amos 3:7 in the KJV, "Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, Unless He reveals His secret to His servants the Prophets." And it is God revealing to us the future through His

Prophets that should be an encouragement to us to see and know that the Lord knew all of this was going to unfold as He said through His Prophets throughout the ages and even in our present age therefore we should all be willing to trust the leading of His Spirit and hear what His Spirit is saying to the Church!

Things that Pastors, Theologians and Preachers have been preaching and teaching for the past 100 years are now manifesting before our very eyes. The possibility of a One world government, virtual currency, the buying and selling with the symbol of the mark of the beast being found in the hand or forehead of the individual; whether this be a chip implant or otherwise, Israel being reborn as a nation, a two-state solutions fighting over the temple mount in Jerusalem, the posturing of Russia and China to gain a foothold of authority in the middle east due to oil wars which ties into Ezekiel chapters 38 and 39, The Palestinian State and the Islamic State uniting together to destroy Israel which ties into Psalm 83 when David prophesied of a coming all-out war between Israel and her neighbors; specifically Iran and Syria at the forefront. All of these points we will discuss over the next several weeks.

What we've heard preached for over a century is now postured to manifest in our current day! We no longer read about Bible prophecy in our Bibles only; we see it on Facebook, FoxNews, CNN, and in the New York Times, it is in our local newspapers, and even manifesting in conversations at home and on the job. Bible prophecy is no longer a future event; it is a current event. I want to be clear that I am not seeking to insight fear but rather to simply point out so much of Bible Prophecy is not capable of being manifest when a century ago, it was hard to fathom how a one world government could manifest and now we have the UN for example. Interesting times indeed.

Having been a student of Eschatology, which is the study of the End Times, I have been asked several times as of late due to the social climate in America and around the world where we are at in God's Prophetic timeline according to Bible Prophecy.

So with that, I am going to take the next month at least and unpack End Times Bible prophecy so I would encourage you to make

notes and go back and watch these messages a few times to absorb as much as you can because it's going to be like drinking from a fire hydrant. Today, I am going to be addressing the expectations of the Church during the end times...

So let's start off in verse one of Matthew 24 to set some ground work as we work our way through this chapter... It is this chapter that will establish a corner stone for my teachings for the rest of this month.

The Gospel of Saint Matthew 24 beginning in verse 1!

- 1. Jesus Foretells the Destruction of Herod's Temple in Matthew 24:1-2
 - a. Jesus left the temple and was going away, when his disciples came to point out to him the buildings of the temple. 2 But he answered them, "You see all these, do you not? Truly, I say to you, there will not be left here one stone upon another that will not be thrown down."
 - b. Jesus prophesied this in 33A.D. and it happened just as he said it would in 70A.D. This Destruction took place in 70AD by

Titus and the Tenth Legion who marched on Jerusalem to put down a revolt.

- c. According to B.L. Cochrell who is a theologian and historical bible scholar, he noted the following, "By the summer of 68 A.D., Jews were nearing defeat by the Roman legions and in 69 A.D., Vespasian was made emperor of Rome and gave his son Titus the honor of delivering the final death blows to the rebellious Jews and their capital city.
- d. In "The Wars of the Jews", Book 6, Josephus notes that, on the eighth day of the Roman month Lous (Jewish month Ab), the ramps were finished and Titus ordered the battering-rams brought up and made ready for an assault on the Temple. With the battering-rams in place the Roman siege of Jerusalem, which began at Passover that year, would come to an end.
- e. As soon as the walls were breached on the 9th of Ab in 70 A.D., a Roman military force of about 30,000 troops under the command of Titus marched into Jerusalem and began a

- systematic slaughter of the Jews and the destruction of the Temple and Jerusalem—exactly as Jesus foretold roughly 40 years earlier.
- f. The Romans brutally slaughtered an estimated 600,000 people in Jerusalem including many of the Passover visitors who had been trapped there for the 143 days during the Roman siege.

 Many of the people who were not killed by Roman soldiers were shipped off to the gladiatorial games, Roman mines, and otherwise exiled from Judea and scattered throughout the Roman empire and other nations.
- g. By the year 73 A.D., all traces of a self-ruling Jewish nation had completely disappeared. Josephus records that the Romans put the city and the Temple to the torch and that these fires were still burning a month later on the eighth day of the Roman month Gorpieus (Jewish month of Elul). The magnificent Temple that Herod had built was completely destroyed as the fires raged inside and out.
- h. These fires were so hot that the gold fittings, and the gold gilding inside and on it's outside walls melted and ran into the

- cracks between and in the stones. During the pillaging of the
 Temple these stones were broken up to get at the gold.
 Therefore, fulfilling Jesus' prophecy that no stone would be left
 on another—the destruction was total, just as Jesus foretold.
- i. NOW LISTEN TO THIS. THIS IS AN ABSOLUTE SIGN OF SOVEREIGNTY: The Temple Solomon built was destroyed by fire on the 9th of Ab in 585 or 586 B.C. (depending on which biblical scholar is doing the research). Just 656 or 657 years later on the 9th of Ab in 70 A.D., the Temple that Herod built was also destroyed. (ON THE SAME DAY OF THE SAME MONTH)
- j. The destruction of both Solomon's Temple and Herod's Temple on the 9th of Ab seems to indicate that, when God's patience comes to an end with his chosen people, he removes his presence and the physical symbolism of his presence from among them to be a witness to future generations that there is a price to pay for disobedience to him. (END OF B.L. COCHRELL QUOTE)

k. If Jesus prophesied this and it happened just as He said it would, then the words that follow this text picking up in Matthew 24:3 lends to the fact that if His previous words came to pass as He said then His following words will come to pass as He said.

2. Signs of the End of the Age

a. Verse 3 As he sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?" 4 And Jesus answered them, "See that no one leads you astray. 5 For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and they will lead many astray. 6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet.7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places. 8 All these are but the beginning of the birth pains. 9 "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and put you to death, and you will be hated by all nations for my name's sake. 10 And then many will fall away and betray one another and hate one another. 11 And many false Prophets will arise and lead many astray.12 And because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold. 13 But the one who endures to the end will be saved.14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

- i. The First Point of Christ in this text is a Spirit of Deception; "See that no one leads you astray."
 - 1. Listen to me Church! We must be led by the Holy
 Ghost in this season that we are in! Not by our
 political party affiliations or our favorite news outlets.
 Discerning the Spirit behind people will protect your
 faith walk and your stability in your Faith during and
 through this season.

- 2. Prayer must be a key and not an option in this season because the Spirit of Anti-Christ has been let loose in the World and especially in our Nation.
- ii. The Second Point of Christ in this text is the rise of false christs; "For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and they will lead many astray."
 - 1. There will be those who will claim deity status and gain followers on a global scale! A simple google search can lend to this point that the Spirit of Anti-Christ is already manifesting in the lives of man and leading them into Doctrines of Devils.
 - 2. Jesus Christ is the Only Christ and He is the ONLY way to Heaven! There are not many ways to Heaven and anyone who teaches this is condemned!
- wars and the rumors of armed conflict in the earth; "And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are

not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet.7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom,"

- 1. Notice Jesus said that we should not be alarmed when we begin to see these things because they must take place but to not think that because we are seeing these things that the end is upon us. As Jesus said, the end is not yet; there are still things yet to come.

 Things are going to get worse...
- 2. Let me share an interesting nugget of truth with you in the Greek of this text; in verse seven, Jesus said that, "For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom," The word Jesus used in the Greek here for nation is the Greek word "Ethnos" which means race and it is where we get our word Ethnic or Ethnicity from in the English language. The word Jesus used in the Greek here for Kingdom is the Greek word, "Basileia" which means royalty or those of wealth.

- 3. With these words defined, let's read it with these words in place of the Greek, "For Race will rise against Race; i.e. ethnic group will rise against ethnic group, (Race Wars) and royalty and those of wealth will rise against royalty and those of wealth,"
- 4. Sound familiar in our current climate in our nation doesn't it? Everyone wants to fight; no one seems to want peace.
- 5. Thus we have the wealthy fighting their wars with currency wars, embargo wars, sanctions and stock market manipulation and we have ethnic groups rising up against one another crying out for armed conflict and bloodshed which is being echoed on all sides. Don't believe me?
- 6. Turn on the news; it is clearly in front of our eyes. In the Church, we have too many ostriches and not enough lions, STOP BURYING OUR HEADS IN THE SAND AND ACTING LIKE WHAT I AM TALKING ABOUT DOESN'T EXIST! WAKE UP!

Our nation seems to be on the verge of civil breakdown and civil conflict.

7. And there are those who are welcoming it with open arms; but hear me well, I am not a prophet nor the son of a prophet but I'm telling you by the Holy Ghost that if our Nation continues down the road it is on then Anarchy and Blood Shed will be the word of the day. We will tear ourselves apart and have no one to blame but ourselves. And the problems that we have today will pale in comparison to what we will have to face if we do not reestablish semblance of order and peace in this Country!

iv. The Fourth Point of Christ in this text is the manifestations of famines and earthquakes in diverse places; "and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places."

- 1. Regarding famines, look at Venezuela. (BUT SOCIALISM WORKS PASTOR! REALLY? LOOK AT VENEZUELA FOR EXAMPLE; VENEZUELA IS A FAILED SOCIAL EXPERIMENT BECAUSE SOCIALISM DOESN'T WORK; IT NEVER HAS AND IT NEVER WILL!) Look at many of the African nations. Look at the United States currently with its lacking ability to keep up with food demands at our previous caliber due to Covid-19 and the social disorder we have in our nation!
- 2. Regarding earthquakes, there are earthquakes happening daily around the world and many of which have created tsunamis that have devastated nations in the past two decades.
- v. The Fifth Point of Christ in this text is the Persecution of the Church; "All these are but the beginning of the birth pains. 9 "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation

and put you to death, and you will be hated by all nations for my name's sake."

- 1. Too many of us think that we are persecuted when someone reports our post of a Bible Scripture on social media or a family member cracks jokes on us or disassociates from us because we go to Church.
- 2. I recently read a quote by a Pastor who said, ""In the New Testament, the mark of radical Christianity was the blood of the martyrs, but now in the American Church the sign of radical Christianity has become whether or not people can consistently show up for Church on Sunday's." And I have to agree with his statement.
- 3. Radical Christianity is what will be demanded in the coming days because the days of powder puff
 Christianity are over. Things in America are going to get more difficult (well Pastor, why can't you be more

- positive?); if you can't see the writing on the wall then you are not paying attention.
- 4. The American consumer driven Church is dying a screaming death because we've made Church about us and not about HIM! "It's all about what I can get and what blesses me and what I want and what I am demanding of the preacher."
- 5. Revelation 18:4 declares, "Then I heard another voice from heaven saying, "Come out of her, my people, lest you take part in her sins, lest you share in her plagues;
- 6. And as your Pastor and a Watchman on the Wall in this Nation, I am sounding a clarion call to you today! Come out of her my people lest you partake in her sins and lest you share in her plagues! Church, it is time to come out of the World! It is time to come out of the World!
- 7. Stop loving sin! Stop chasing the pleasures of this world because this world will soon come to naught! I

- know this is hard preaching and some folks might say it's old timey and outdated but you had better heed my words today!
- 8. I am not the candy man; I am not going to help you make the world taste good! Holiness is still right!

 There is still a righteous standard that the Cross of Christ demands! And I am tired of seeing people destroy their lives because they have a form of godliness but deny the power thereof! If you can't live for Christ now then you will never live for Him when persecution comes!

9. If you die and go to Hell, it's going to be over my preaching, and over my prayers, and over my tears, and over my pleadings and over my interventions and over my willingness to tell you the truth. As I said a few minutes ago, I am not the candy man; I am not going to help you make the world taste good! I am not

- going to tell you that evil is good and good is evil so you will pay your tithe and show up at Church so I can say I had a crowd.
- 10.I would rather have 500 folks who love Jesus and are filled with the Power of the Holy ghost and have the Power to touch Heaven than I would have 3000 folks who I have to change their diapers and spoon feed them some pablum and lull them to sleep to keep them happy. It's time to grow up because I'm not that kind of Pastor!
- 11.If you are looking for that here, I am not the Pastor you are looking for! I will love you and walk with you and lock arms with you to walk through Hell to get you to Heaven but I am too old and time is too short to play games with Eternity! And the Lord is expecting His church to grow up from being a spoiled bratty child who whines when she doesn't get her way and mature into the Bride of Christ adorned for Husband and bound for Glory!

- vi. The Sixth Point of Christ in this text is the falling away of Luke Warm Christians because of persecution; "10 And then many will fall away and betray one another and hate one another."
 - 1. Now the following statement is going to be very candid and I want to be clear that I am not addressing this to everyone but rather to whom it may apply so filter my words and discern. But if the shoe fits, lace it up!
 - 2. I've heard and read more rhetoric from more people screaming that the Church is essential and should be allowed to be open. But so many of these same people never found the Church essential to attend before COVID-19 so why are you defending an institution that you were never devoted to to begin with? You don't serve, you don't give, you don't tithe, you don't support your pastor, you have no stable attendance record to speak of but you want to try to impress others with your religious talk. We have prayer

meeting and you won't show up; we have virtual broadcasts to teach you the word of God and you won't tune in. We have church services and you show up once a month.

- 3. You want to rattle your sabers because you are more concerned about what others perceive about you than what our Heavenly Father knows about you.

 Facebook should have to undergo a name change to Fakebook.
- 4. This season has unveiled the religious spirits and the lack of purpose in the lives of so many who claim to be a part of the Church of Jesus Christ but they are actually of their Father, The Devil.
- 5. So many have rose up as a champion of the Church because they are using our plight as a means of driving a political agenda.

- 6. "Well this is hard preaching pastor! I thought you loved me and cared about me! Why can't you tell me about how much Jesus loves me and how He has a plan for my life!" I do love you and I do care about you but I am not going to love you Hell because I was afraid to tell you the truth to get you into Heaven!
- 7. Revelation 3:14-22 To the Church in Laodicea 14 "And to the angel of the Church in Laodicea write: 'The words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of God's creation. 15 "I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot! 16 So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth. 17 For you say, I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing, not realizing that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked. (HE IS TALKING TO THE CHURCH!)

¹⁸ I counsel you to buy from me gold refined by fire, so that you may be rich, and white garments so that you

may clothe yourself and the shame of your nakedness may not be seen, and salve to anoint your eyes, so that you may see. 19 Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent (REPEAT). ²⁰ Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. ²¹ The one who conquers, I will grant him to sit with me on my throne, as I also conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne. 22 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the Churches."

8. And He that hath an ear, hear what the Spirit is saying today! This letter was written to the Angel of the Church of Laodicea; the Angel noted here is the Pastor of the Church. This letter is not only correcting the Church; it is correcting the Pastor of the Church.

- 9. And as a Pastor in America, I have a message for the Church of the United States of America! We are the Church of Laodicea! We are luke-warm; We are wretched, We are pitiable, We are poor, we are blind, and we are naked.
- 10.Wretchedness has filled our Churches! Evil and Sin are being exposed at every level of leadership and stature of ministry and even within the Church body itself.
- 11.We are pitiable! We haven't the intestinal fortitude of faith enough to be faithful to pray, to study our bible or love on people but God forbid that our religious procedures, also known as Church, be prohibited from numbing our consciences because we would rather be lulled by preachers than convicted by the Holy Ghost to live right!
- 12.We want "Church" to happen so that we can deceive ourselves into thinking that we are devoted to Christ because we go to a building once or twice a week but

we truly are not devoted to Christ; we are devoted to silencing the accusations of conscience. Many are not even devoted to their spouses or their children much less to Christ or His Church!

- 13.We are Poor and Blind because we have convinced ourselves that our wealth is found in what we build rather than who we build and having a vision for the future of our Church. And as your Pastor, I want you to hear my heart.
- 14.I love this building we are in, I'm thankful for our facilities, the technology that we have and what our facilities provide for us to do ministry in and through to reach people.
- 15.But I am not concerned with building buildings; I am focused on building you. I can't take this building to Heaven with me but I can take you with me if you will let me! As Paul said, Follow Me as I Follow Christ! Let us not fall into the trap of thinking that our facilities make us rich; it is the building of people

- that makes us rich not our budgets and buildings! What we build with our hands will pass away but what we build with our Words and our lives' examples is eternal!
- 16.And lastly so many of us are naked! We want the benefits of the Church but not its covering. We want the title but not the reproof.
- 17.And if I am your pastor, I have the responsibility to cover you spiritually and uphold a righteous standard but I also have the responsibility to reproof, to correct, to develop and to lead this House.
- 18.And as we grow and expand and reach more people, we will attract all sorts of folks but here's the bottom line; there is no greater spiritual authority in the local Church than the Pastor of that Local Church and if I am not your covering then I am not your Pastor.
- 19.Let me be clear! I don't want to be your Preacher!
 You can get that on YouTube! I want to be your
 Pastor and there is a difference!

- Prophets; "11 And many false Prophets will arise and lead many astray.12 And because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold. 13 But the one who endures to the end will be saved."
 - 1. And to bring some order to the Prophetic gifts operating in the Church; you are either an in-house Prophet or an out-house Prophet.
 - 2. An In-House Prophet submits his or her Prophetic giftings and words to the Pastor and assists the Pastor in developing the Church for the season we are in as well as the seasons that are to come.
 - 3. If you are not willing to submit your Prophetic giftings and words to the Pastor and assist the Pastor in developing the Church then you are an out-house Prophet. He that hath an ear let him interpret. Don't get mad at me for bringing order because a sign of

- the end times is a rise in false Prophets. And that spirit will not be allowed in this House.
- 4. The Five Fold Ministry was given to the Church by
 Christ to equip the Church to do the Work of the
 Ministry. If you are using your gifts to build your own
 name then you are prostituting the anointing to build
 a kingdom that is an enemy of the Cross of Christ!
- 5. I am so tired of Apostle such and such and Prophet
 Such and such and Chief Apostle such and such and
 Reverend Bishop Dr. such and such! We are
 consumed with our titles but we have no character of
 Christ to speak of.
- 6. I'm talking to preachers and those who claim to be in the Ministry. Show me your home before you preach me a sermon. Show me your marriage before you try to impress me with your titles and your degrees. Show me your integrity and your character and the truthfulness of your words before you try to speak

into my life. SHOW ME THE FRUIT BECAUSE THE WORLD IS WATCHING!!!

- 7. The Bible says, "And because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold."
- 8. This isn't strictly relegated to the World; the World has always been lawless. Jesus is talking about the Church being lawless itself with no boundaries or restrictions in place to protect our witness! Everyone seems to be doing what is right in their own eyes!
- 9. Paul told Timothy in 2 Timothy 3:1-9, "3 But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty. ² For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, ³ heartless, unappeasable, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not loving good, ⁴ treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ having the appearance of godliness, but denying its

power. Avoid such people. ⁶ For among them are those who creep into households and capture weak women, burdened with sins and led astray by various passions, ⁷ always learning and never able to arrive at a knowledge of the truth. ⁸ Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the truth, men corrupted in mind and disqualified regarding the faith. ⁹ But they will not get very far, for their folly will be plain to all, as was that of those two men."

10.But verse 13 gives us some direction and hope in the midst of the Struggle! "But the one who endures to the end will be saved!" Church, it is time to endure, it is time to press forward, it is time to keep plowing, it is time to remain faithful! Now is not the time to shrink back!

viii. The Eighth Point of Christ in this text makes it clear that in spite of all of this calamity and difficulty and war and

famine that the Gospel of the Kingdom will be preached around the World and then the end shall come! "14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come."

- a. The Great Commission is not sidelined by crisis in the Earth!
- b. Do we not understand that the Church is the medium by which the Great Commission is to be fulfilled in the World?
- c. Do we not understand that the Church is the medium by which the Voice of the Infinite and His purpose burst into language and are made to be heard!
- d. THE SAD REALITY OF ALL THIS IS THAT

 It's been so long since we've seen a church that

 truly desired revival, we don't rightfully know

 what one looks like!

- e. When Jesus gave issuance of the Great

 Commission to the Church, He promised to
 accompany the Preaching of the Kingdom with
 the Demonstration and Power of that Kingdom!
- f. Therefore it would seem to reason that a Church which is not performing the duties assigned to it by the Great commission has surrendered its Biblical right to exist! A Church that does not perform the Great Commission is a Great Imposter!
- g. And The Assembly West Monroe will not be found guilty of being an imposter!
- h. Do we not understand that Kingdoms will crumble, monument will parish, societies will collapse, the pyramids will melt away, governments will topple, armies will be defeated but the Work of the Church will stand while the world is dying because none of these factors hold sway regarding the Great Commission! Jesus

- said, "14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come."
- i. And as far as The Assembly West Monroe is concerned, we are going to preach the Gospel in word and in deed, we are going to finance missionaries and ministries around the Globe, we are going to impact the Twin Cities, our Parish and our State, we are going to strive for peace with all men as much as it lies within us, we are going to embrace our families, pour our lives into our children and we are going to occupy until He comes for His Church!
