He was a traveling ministry partner of Paul

He wrote about those journeys in the book of Acts

Luke's Gospel Is An Orderly Narrative Of The Life Of Christ

It Emphasizes The Heart Of Jesus For Humanity & The Needy

In Luke We Find The Most Complete Picture Of The Life Of Jesus

Jesus Taught The Blessings Of His Kingdom And The Woes To Those Who Live Only For The Kingdom's Of This World

- He taught them about love, grace, giving, and mercy
- That there was a difference between being wise and foolish
- And about what you should build your life on
- About faith and the keys to Kingdom power & life

Jesus Answered The Question Of John The Baptist "Are You The One?" Luke 7:20–23

- He Forgave The Sins Of One Who Had Anointed His Feet
- He Told The Parable Of The Sower & The Seed
- The Soil In The Heart Determines The Harvest & Increase
- He Instructed His Disciples To Let Their Light Shine

Jesus' disciples were seeing, hearing and experiencing something different from anything that they had ever experienced before.

Jesus was teaching a new way of life

- a new order in life
- the order of the Kingdom

Luke 9:1: the Kingdom of Christ is one of power, dominion & authority it is aligned against demons & diseases

Luke 9:2: He told them to do 2 things:

- 1. Preach the Kingdom
- 2. Heal the sick

Luke 9:3-5: This Is No Ordinary Kingdom

- It Is Not A Kingdom Of This World.
- It Is Far Above The Structures Of The World's Kingdoms

Luke 9:6: They Set Out And Did It

- Preaching The Gospel Of The Kingdom
- Healing People Everywhere
- Their Faith Was Seen Through Their Obedience

Luke 9:7-9: Herod Antipas Is Concerned About This New King

• **The Lesson:** Anytime We Represent The King And His Kingdom There Is A Necessary Point Of Separation From The World And Its Desires

Luke 9:10-12: Christ Affirms an important purpose of the Kingdom: To reach and teach people for the Kingdom of God

 As The Massive Crowd Approaches – Jesus is Not Demoralized – He is Energized

Luke 9:13-17: Jesus Told His Disciples To Feed The Crowd

He is Teaching a Kingdom Principle:

- In The Kingdom There Is No Shortage Of Natural Resources
- In Earthly Math -- It Didn't Add Up (5 Loaves + 2 Fish for 1,000's)
- In Kingdom Math -- It Was More Than Enough!

There Is A Supernatural Supply & Provision In The Kingdom

Luke 9:18-20: Peter Got It. He Knew Who Jesus Was

Luke 9:20 "But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?" Peter answered, "God's Messiah."

Peter Had Expressed The Exact Truth:

Jesus Is The Christ -- The Messiah -- The Lord

- This Is Where Kingdom Life Begins. (Christ is King)
- This Is Where Kingdom Function Is Activated

Luke 9:21-27: Jesus Said: "Don't Tell Anyone."

• There Were Still Things That Jesus Had To Fulfill

You Can't Live In Two Kingdoms At The Same Time

• You Must Decide And Choose: The Kingdoms Of This World Or The Kingdom Of God

Luke 9:27 (NIV) — **27** "Truly I tell you, some who are standing here will not taste death before they see the kingdom of God."

 What Was He Describing? The Rapture? The Second Coming? No, He is Describing the Transfiguration

Luke 9:28–30 (NIV) — 28 About eight days after Jesus said this, he took Peter, John and James with him and went up onto a mountain to pray. 29 As he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became as bright as a flash of lightning. 30 Two men, Moses and Elijah, appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus

Luke 9:28-36:On That Mountain They Saw Firsthand:

- Jesus Being Glorified
- Jesus being testified of by Moses and Elijah
- The coming of the Kingdom of God amongst them
- it would be something for them to experience, and it would change their lives and impact them immensely.

 Everything That Jesus Said And Did -- Confirmed The Reality Of The Kingdom

 Jesus Wanted All The People To Realize – There Is A King, There Is A Kingdom
