• Genesis 11:5–9 (NIV) 5 But the LORD came down to see the city and the tower the people were building. 6 The LORD said, "If as one people speaking the same language they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them. 7 Come, let us go down and confuse their language so they will not understand each other." 8 So the LORD scattered them from there over all the earth, and they stopped building the city. 9 That is why it was called Babel—because there the LORD confused the language of the whole world. From there the LORD scattered them over the face of the whole earth

It Was Built in Rebellion Against God and His Declared Will

Nimrod Was Chief Antagonist And Leader

He Built the Original City of Babylon

 They Said, "Let's Build Us A City So That We Can Make A Name For Ourselves"

Their Mindset Is Pride

"Pride Goes Before Destruction"

Nimrod And His Group Of Followers Wanted Four Things:

- 1. They Wanted To Build A City
- 2. They Wanted **To Build A Tower** That Would Reach To The Heavens
- 3. They Wanted **To Make A Name** For Themselves
- 4. They Wanted **To Not Be Dispersed** Over The Whole Earth

BABYLON -- The Word Has **A Dual Significance**: It Means **One Thing To Man –Another To God**

 In the language of the Babylonians The Word Babel Meant "THE GATE OF GOD."

God Gave It His Own Definition

– CONFUSION

Babel Wasn't A Gate To The Gods It Was A Door To Confusion

The Spirit Of Babel Lives On From That Time Until This

There Is Still A Desire Today for:

- A One World Religion
- A One World Government
- A One World Economy

This One World System -- One World Leader And One World Religion Is Being Set Up – Like Babel Of Old

 Anti-Christ Is Going To Hijack The One World System And Attempt To Make It His Own

Anti-Christ Will Make A Fatal Mistake

- He will stretch forth his hand to touch the holy things of God.
- He will seek to conquer the Holy Land, But God Will Step In!

What Began At The Tower Of Babel Is A "Babylonian" Being Revived In Our Day

These Are Signs Of The Last Of Days

• The Anti-Christ And False Prophet Will Institute A One World Commercial, Political And Religious System Dedicated To Wiping Out All Believers And All Jews.

What was the mistake of Nimrod And His Conspirators? They left God out of their plans.

Their plans were to exalt their name – NOT GOD!

- Their tower fell short of God's standard

- Rebellion is defiant acts and attitudes towards God.
- A decision to reject and not respect or obey God.
- To come against God's leading and direction.
- To willfully dismiss the commands of God.

- 3 Facts About Rebellion And Us.
- 1. Rebellion is part of our nature
- 2. Rebellion is a choice that we make.
- 3. Rebellion always leads to judgment

• Anytime God's people continue in sin, it is to their own detriment.

God Defines Disobedience As Sin

- 1. Disobedience can limit future opportunities
- 2. Disobedience brings us to a very fearful place. (Heb. 10:31)
- 3. Disobedience receives God's judgment
- 4. The wages of disobedience and rebellion can reap long term negative results.

Why Did God Stop The Building Of The City And Tower?

 God hates the independent spirit of people who believe & declare that they can make it without Him

 He knew if this spirit were allowed to go unchecked it would spread like a germ to many other lives

If People Don't Deal With Rebellion, God Will!

- When We Justify And Excuse Our Sin
- When We Rationalize Our Disobedience
- When We Think Our Way Of Worship Is Better Than God's Way
- It Means that We Are Glorifying Self Over God

- (Gen 11:6 NIV) The LORD said, "If as one people speaking the same language, they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them
- Nothing They Plan To Do Will Be Impossible For Them Whether Good Or Bad

What Did God Do??

- He Confused Their Language
- And He Scattered Them

Humanity Has Become Able And Capable Whenever They Come Together In Unity

It Is Incredible What Can Be Accomplished in Unity

These Things Can Be Good & Beneficial Or Bad & Destructive

 Too Often The Incredible Accomplishments Of People In Unity Most Often Lead People Away From God – Not Towards Him

- (Genesis 11:4 NIV) the LORD confused the language of the whole world. From there the LORD scattered them over the face of the whole earth.
- In Unity it is almost Unlimited regarding what man can do
- God Made The Determination To Scatter Them, And Confuse Their Languages
- This Would Be Preferred To A United And Unified Falling Away In Apostasy

 One Of The Powerful Lessons From This Passage About Babel Is: <u>The Tremendous Power And Potential Of Unity</u>

• United We Stand, Divided We Fall.

 Jesus Taught Us That Unity Is A Powerful Principle Of The Kingdom. (Matt 18: 18-19)

There Are Lessons On Unity For The Church

- 1. We Need Each Other
- 2. We Need To Be Working As A Team
- 3. We Need To Learn How To Win Together
- 4. We Need Each Other We Can Only Win Together

God Had To Break Things Up At The Tower Of Babel

When They Were Together – Their Strength Multiplied

 Though It Was A Negative At Babel It Can Be A Great Positive In The Church Today

- (1 Pet 3:8 NIV) Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble.
- We Must Have A Spirit Of Unity In The Church
- It Has To Start With A Value, Desire, And Drive In Us
- We Won't See The Effects Until It is In Our Hearts

Unity Is Vital In The Important Things:

- 1. Jesus Christ The Way, Truth And Life
- 2. Our Purposes As A Church: Serve Worship Outreach– Relationship Discipleship
- 3. Being In Agreement With God's Heart And Plan For His Church

Jesus Prayed "Father That They Maybe One As We Are"

• (John 17:23 NIV) "May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me."

• If We Would Follow Christ's Lead, We Could See Great Thing Take Place

4 Things Unity Does:

- 1. Unity Answers The Prayer Request Of Christ
- 2. Unity Binds Us Together
- 3. Unity Helps Us Carry Out God's Plan
- 4. Unity Brings The Anointing Of The Holy Spirit

Psalm 133 (NIV) — A song of ascents. Of David. **1** How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity! **2** It is like precious oil poured on the head, running down on the beard, running down on Aaron's beard, down on the collar of his robe. **3** It is as if the dew of Hermon were falling on Mount Zion. For there the LORD bestows his blessing, even life forevermore.

- Unity Is Like Oil It Is Symbolic Of The Work Of The Holy Spirit Between Us When We Are Together
- When We Have The Spirit Of Unity We Don't Grind On Each Other And We Don't Irritate Each Other

Unity Testifies Of Christ -- On The Other Hand:

- 1. Disunity Denies Christ And His Prayer
- 2. Disunity Breaks The Bond Of Peace
- 3. Disunity Causes Us To Fail
- 4. Disunity Displaces The Anointing

We Must Be United and Have A Spirit Led Unity

 Our Prayer And Ministry Teams Can't Be Powerful If We Are Not In Unity

 Our Unity As A Church Is Of Utmost Importance---We Can't Let It Slide!

We Must Not Allow Anything To Stand In The Way Of Unity

- "A House Divided Against Itself Cannot Stand"
- They Can't Pray Powerfully
- They Can't Minister Effectively
- They Can't And They Won't Go Forward
