"Luke emphasizes that they were "sent on their way by the Holy Spirit." The Holy Spirit is a Person. They did not treat him as a power "to seize and use," as Simon had wanted to do (Acts 8:19). Paul and Barnabas were willing to let the Holy Spirit use them. He sent them. He continued to be with them."


