Bondage Is:

The State Of Being Under Control Of A Force Or Influence

The State Of One Who Is Bound As In Captivity Or Slavery

How Does Someone Become Bound?

CAPTIVITY TAKES PLACE – Binding us in any area of our lives where we come into agreement with a lie from the enemy that is in direct opposition to God's Word. That is an open door in those areas, it gives the enemy legal access, and it's like an open invitation for them to come and torment us.

- ■Ephesians 4:27 (NIV) "do not give the devil a foothold"
- When You Open A Door To The Enemy, He Has The Legal Right To Establish A Stronghold In Your Life

- Disobedience
- Generational curses
- Ignorance of God's Word

■ The Opposite Of Bondage Is Freedom And Liberty

The Three Stages Of Bondage

Stage One: Ignorance, Strong Holds And Deception

Stage Two: Is Where Legal Rights Are Involved

Stage Three: Demons Must Be Driven Out

Important Tools We Have Been Given To Set Captives Free

- ■Prayer And Fasting:
- ■Understand Your Authority: DELEGATED POWER
- ■Binding And Loosing: Binding Is Like Spiritual Handcuffing
- ■Loosing Is When A Captive Is Loosed From Something
- Casting Out Demons

- That Is What Jesus Wants To Do For You, Too.
- It Doesn't Matter What Your Problem May Be,
- Jesus Is Ready To Set You Free.
- The Only Thing We Must Be Willing To Do Is Give Up The Life Of Sin, Acknowledge That We Are Sinners, And Ask For God's Pardon.

What Can I Do?

- 1. Realize That Jesus Wants You To Be Free!
- 2. Believe He Has Supplied Everything It Takes To Get Free!
- 3. Know That It All Starts With Repentance
- 4. Turn From All Known Sin

TAKE THE STEPS TO FREEDOM

- ■Know that God is able to deliver you and wants to set you free.
- Prayerfully put on the armor of God --Make it personal
- Take your authority
