

In the Christian faith, everything rises and falls on the resurrection of Christ

• (1 Cor 15:17 NIV) And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins.

• The nature of the wisdom of God is centered on this foundation of our faith -- Jesus lived, died, and rose again!

- Truth #1 The Wisdom & Plan Of God Can't Be Stopped, Shut Up Or Sealed Away
- Matthew 27:57–61 (NIV) 57 As evening approached, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus. 58 Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus' body, and Pilate ordered that it be given to him. 59 Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, 60 and placed it in his own new tomb that he had cut out of the rock. He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away. 61 Mary Magdalene and the other Mary were sitting there opposite the tom the Lord.

God Has A (His) Way Of Getting Things Done

 When God has a plan, He often finds a man or a woman to work through

- Joseph of Arimathea, Mary and Mary, Peter & John
- God uses them to accomplish his plan

• Matthew 27:62–66 (NIV) — 62 The next day, the one after Preparation Day, the chief priests and the Pharisees went to Pilate. 63 "Sir," they said, "we remember that while he was still alive that deceiver said, 'After three days I will rise again.' 64 So give the order for the tomb to be made secure until the third day. Otherwise, his disciples may come and steal the body and tell the people that he has been raised from the dead. This last deception will be worse than the first." 65 "Take a guard," Pilate answered. "Go, make the tomb as secure as you know how." 66 So they went and made the tomb secure by putting a seal on the stone and posting the guard.

None of these security measures mattered. They all fall away before the wisdom and power of Christ & His resurrection power!

The Pharisees & Pilate did all they could to "stop the steal"

In the end they couldn't do a thing

 Matthew 28:1–4(NIV) — 1 After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb. 2 There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. 3 His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. 4 The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men.

• Matthew 28:5–10(NIV) — 5 The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. 6 He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. 7 Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.' Now I have told you." 8 So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples. 9 Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings," he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him. 10 Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me."

• Truth #2 -- The Wisdom Of God Is Seen In The Sunrise It Reminds Us That After The Darkness – The Son Rose!

 Truth #3 --In The Wisdom Of God Everyday Is A Fitting Day To Worship – But Sunday Works Really Well

• Matthew 28:1 (NIV) — 1 After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb.

- Christians in the early churches met together often on the first day of each week.
- Christians commonly referred to the first day of the week as the Lord's Day.
- This was because it was the day on which Jesus rose from the dead as the triumphant Lord

 Truth #4 -- God Uses Signs & Wonders To Declare The Plan & Wisdom Of God

• Matthew 28:2–4 (NIV) — 2 There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. 3 His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. 4 The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men.

Divine times of impact & change; are often followed with signs in nature – we refer to these as "signs and wonders"

They are not coincidental & without purpose

The signs and wonders we see signal something from God

- Truth #5 --In The Wisdom Of God, You Won't Find Christ In The Tomb Or On The Cross – He Has Risen
- "Don't look for the living among the dead"
- The stone has been removed the tomb is empty
- The burial clothes are there
- The presence of angels testify
- Jesus isn't there -- He is risen

What is the significance of the Resurrection?

- It proves that Jesus is God's Son
- It verifies the truth of Scripture
- It assures our own future resurrection
- The entire structure of the Christian faith rests on the foundation of the Resurrection. If we do away with His resurrection, we have no hope.
