WHAT IS SALVATION?

 Salvation is deliverance from the penalty, pollution, and power of sin

• "For by grace are ye saved through faith."—Eph. 2:8.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO TO BE SAVED?

 Acts 16:30–31 (NIV) — 30 He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" 31 They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."

WHO IS SAVED & HOW ARE WE SAVED?

• Everyone who believes in Jesus Christ.

• "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved"

WHAT ARE WE SAVED FROM?

- From our guilt.
- From being displeasing to God.
- From the condemnation of our conscience.
- From the power of sin.
- From future judgment.

WHAT ARE WE SAVED TO?

- We are saved to eternal life.
- We are saved to peace and joy.
- We are saved to a pure, holy, and useful life.
- We are saved to be God's favor and delight.
- We are saved to be children of God.
- We are saved to an inheritance.

HOW ARE WE SAVED?

- 1. We are saved by grace. Salvation is a gift.
- We are saved by grace through faith (Eph 2:8)

James 2:17–18 (NIV) — 17 In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead. 18 But someone will say, "You have faith; I have deeds." Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by my deeds.

WHAT IS SIN?

• "Sin is any thought, word, or deed that either violates or falls short of complete conformity to God's holy laws."

• Romans 3:23 (NIV) — 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

WHAT HAS GOD DONE ABOUT THE OBSTACLE OF SIN IN US?

- 1 Corinthians 15:3–5 (NIV) 3 For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, 5 and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve.
- Romans 5:8 (NIV) 8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

WHO DID CHRIST DIE FOR?

 Christ died for people who have nothing to offer Him but brokenness and need

John 1:12 (NIV) — **12** Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God—

John 3:16–18 (NIV) — 16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. 18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.

HOW DO WE RECEIVE SALVATION?

Salvation is freely given to all who believe in Jesus

• John 6:47 (NIV) — 47 Very truly I tell you, the one who believes has eternal life.

Salvation Has Freed Us In Our Past - From Sin's Penalty

= We Have Been Saved

Salvation Frees Us In The Present – From Sin's Power

= We Are Being Saved

Salvation Frees Us In The Future - From Sin's Presence

= We Will Be Saved

HOW TO KNOW THAT YOU ARE SAVED AND GOING TO HEAVEN:

1 John 5:11–13 (NIV) — 11 And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. 12 Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life. 13 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.

The Only Way Is Through Jesus Christ

• **John 14:6 (NIV)** — **6** Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Without Christ We Don't Have Eternal Life

• 1 John 5:12 (NIV) — 12 Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

HOW DO WE TAKE HOLD OF AND POSSESS THIS FOR OURSELVES?

John 3:16 (NIV) — 16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:36 (NIV) — 36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them.

- John 6:29 (NIV) 29 Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent."
- John 6:40 (NIV) 40 For my Father's will is that <u>everyone</u> who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day."
- John 6:47 (NIV) 47 Very truly I tell you, the one who believes has eternal life.

To Believe In Him – Is Not Simply To Believe That He Exists

To Believe In Him – Is to Place Our Faith & Trust In Him

- It is about being fully committed to Him
- To fully trust and rely on him so much so that you are fully committed to him
