- 1. Satan Is A Deceiver
- 2. Only God Is Omnipotent, Omnipresent And Omniscient
- 3. Satan Is A Defeated Foe; We Are Overcomers In Christ

Step Six: Freedom vs Bondage

• 1 Cor. 10:13 ... "when we're tempted God is faithful and he will provide a way of escape."

• **Romans 8:15 (NKJV)** (15) For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father."

How Does Someone Become Bound?

- Spiritual Bondage Occurs Where We Come Into Agreement With A Lie From The Enemy
- In Rejecting God's Truth, We Are Susceptible To The Enemy's Lies
- Rejecting God's Truth & Authority Opens The Door To The Enemy
- A Stronghold That Is Not Contained Takes Over Your Life

We can be bound because of:

- Habitual Sin, Giving Into The Lusts Of Our Flesh
- <u>Disobedience</u>
- Generational Curses

Exodus 34:7 - "I lavish unfailing love to a thousand generations. I forgive iniquity, rebellion, and sin. But I do not excuse the guilty. I lay the sins of the parents upon their children and grandchildren; the entire family is affected-even children in the third and fourth generations."

Ignorance Of God's Word Can Keep Us In Bondage

- **Hosea 4:6** "My people are destroyed from lack of knowledge"
- Isaiah 5:13 "Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because they have no knowledge: and their honorable men are famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst"

- Confession Leads To Healing: The Next Step To Freedom For Those Dealing With Habitual Sin Is To Confess It, Not Cover It
- James 5:16 (NIV) 16 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.
- **Proverbs 28:13 (NIV) 13** He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them finds mercy.
