1. THE CITY and CHURCH at PERGAMUM

- "Per" means "Opposition." "Gamos" means "Marriage."
- Pergamos = "objectionable marriage"
- PERGAMOS was mainly known for its religions and idolatry.
- The Lord said, "I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is."
- Jesus was saying, "You are living in a city where Satan's influence is strong."

2. CHRIST THE CREATOR OF THE LETTER—2:12

• Revelation 2:12 (NIV) — 12 "To the angel of the church in Pergamum write: These are the words of him who has the sharp, double-edged sword.

The "Sharp Double-edged Sword" Is The Word Of God.

• The Word Of God Can Defeat Deception, Error & Satanic Opposition.
