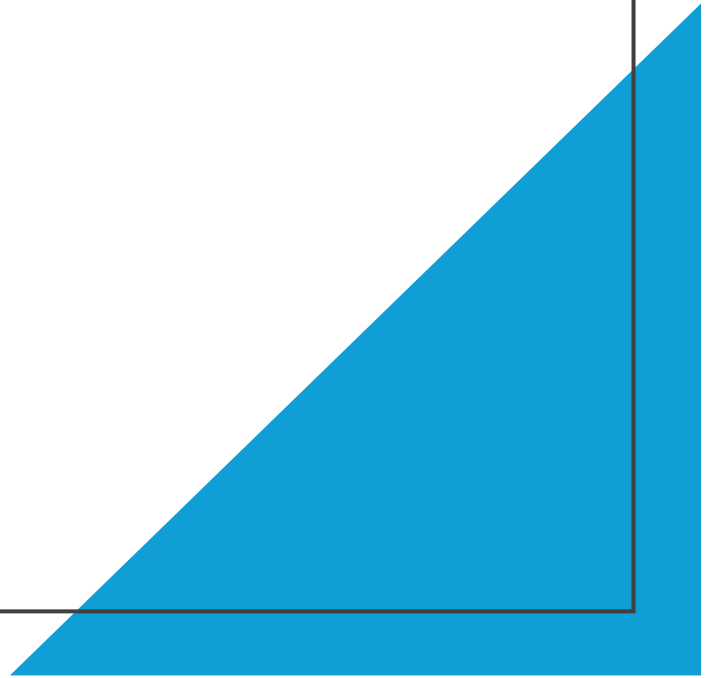

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

What Was Adam & Eve's Attitude When They Sinned In The Garden?

- A. *They wanted to be free from God.*
- B. *They bought into the serpent's question "did God really say?"*
- C. *They believed his way would be better "you will not surely die"*
- D. *They put their faith in the serpent's words "you will be a God"*

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

Genesis 3:14-15 (NKJV) 14 So the LORD God said to the serpent: "Because you have done this, You are cursed more than all cattle, And more than every beast of the field; On your belly you shall go, And you shall eat dust All the days of your life. 15 And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel."

- **This is a “seed war.”**
- **The Seed War is a Battle Between Bloodlines**

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- DID ADAM & EVE SUCCEED IN THEIR MISSION?
- the birth of Cain – brought disaster
- SIN DIDN'T STOP THERE... IT GOT WORSE AND WORSE
- This rapid growth of sinful rebellion became so bad God could no longer tolerate i

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **READ: Genesis 6:1–8**

1. The **intensity** and **extent** of evil *was great in the earth*.
2. Man's **thoughts** and **imaginings of heart** were entirely evil.
3. Man's total dedication was to evil. He thought *only evil*.
4. The evil was **habitual**; It was part of him *all the time*.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **Genesis 6:5** And the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- HOW DID GOD DESTROY THE TERRIBLE EVIL IN THE EARTH?
- God sent a great flood to destroy the evil from off the earth
- **Genesis 6:17 (NIV)** I am going to bring floodwaters on the earth to destroy all life under the heavens, every creature that has the breath of life in it. Everything on earth will perish.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- HAS GOD FAILED IN HIS PURPOSE WITH MANKIND?
IS EVERYBODY GOING TO HAVE TO BE DESTROYED?
- Everyone on earth **was not** to be destroyed
- *Noah found (FAVOR) grace in the eyes of the LORD.*

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- The principle of the *remnant*: God saves a small part out of the large group
- The remnant included Noah and his wife, his three sons and their wives.
- In addition to these human lives, a remnant of animals and birds were saved.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **Genesis 6:8 (NIV)** But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD.
- **Genesis 7:1 (NIV)** The LORD then said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and your whole family, because I have found you righteous in this generation.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- *“ Man (is) Appointed Mortal Sorrow; (but) The Blessed God Shall Come Down Teaching (that) His Death Shall Bring (the) Despairing Rest”*
- **What Is This? It Is God’s Plan To Redeem Fallen Man**
- *In the earliest chapters of Genesis, God had already laid out His plan for Redemption – Chuck Missler*

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **Jesus Gives His Disciples A Private Update**
- **Matthew 24:1-3 (NIV)** ¹ Jesus left the temple and was walking away when his disciples came up to him to call his attention to its buildings. ² "Do you see all these things?" he asked. "I tell you the truth, not one stone here will be left on another; every one will be thrown down."
³ As Jesus was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately. **"Tell us," they said, "when will this happen, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?"**

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **Matthew 24:4-5 (NIV)** ⁴ Jesus answered: "Watch out that no one deceives you. ⁵ For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many.
- **Matthew 24:37-39 (NIV)** ³⁷ As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. ³⁸ For in the days before the flood, people were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day Noah entered the ark; ³⁹ and they knew nothing about what would happen until the flood came and took them all away. That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **When The Days Start Being Like They Were In Noah's Day... That's When Jesus Return Is At Hand...**
- ***How Were The Days Of Noah? What Made Them Unique?***
- **Genesis 6:1-2 (NIV)** ¹ When men began to increase in number on the earth and daughters were born to them, ² the sons of God saw that the daughters of men were beautiful, and they married any of them they chose (DESIRED).

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **Who Are The “Sons Of God” ? They Are Angels**
- **Who Are The “Daughters Of Men”? The Daughters of Adam**
- **The Sons Of God Took Wives For Themselves From The Daughters Of Man And The Result Is They Sire Superhuman Offspring**
- **Genesis 6:4 (NIV)** The Nephilim were on the earth in those days--and also afterward--when the sons of God went to the daughters of men and had children by them. They were the heroes of old, men of renown.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **The Nephilim**
- Hebrew Nephilim = “the fallen ones”: Hebrew *Nephal*: to fall, be cast down, to fall away, desert
- Also, Hebrew; *HaGibborim* = “the mighty ones.” “Giants”

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **The seed is corrupted**
- **Genesis 6:5-8 (NIV)** ⁵ The LORD saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil all the time. ⁶ The LORD was grieved that he had made man on the earth, and his heart was filled with pain. ⁷ So the LORD said, "I will wipe mankind, whom I have created, from the face of the earth--men and animals, and creatures that move along the ground, and birds of the air--for I am grieved that I have made them." ⁸ But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- Sin and wickedness has pretty much affected the entirety of creation except for one family:
- **Noah Has An Unblemished Genealogy**
- **Genesis 6:9 (NKJV)** This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, **perfect** in his generations. Noah walked with God.
- **Genesis 6:9 (NIV)** This is the account of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, **blameless** among the people of his time, and he walked with God.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- “**BLAMELESS**” or “**PERFECT**” Hebrew *tamiyn* = without blemish, sound, healthful, without spot, unimpaired. This term is always used of *physical* blemishes, not moral ones
- “*The Rebellion Of The Fallen Ones Had Gotten Into The Gene Pool & Offspring To The Place Where The Spirit Of Man Was Rotten. Mankind Was Officially Corrupted*”

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **THE New Testament Confirms THIS...**
- **Jude 1:6-7 (NKJV)** ⁶ And the angels who did not keep their proper domain (PRINCIPALITY, POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY) , but left their own abode (HABITATION, PROPER DWELLING PLACE), He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness for the judgment (AND DOOM) of the great day; ⁷ as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities around them in a similar manner to these, having given themselves over to sexual immorality (FORNICATION AND PERVERSION, UNNATURAL VICE, SENSUAL PERVERSITY) and gone after strange flesh, are set forth as an example, suffering the vengeance (PUNISHMENT) of eternal fire.

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

Peter Also Mentions The Same Incident:

- 2 Peter 2:4 (NKJV) For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell (TARTARUS) and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment;

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- *Where The Sons Of God (Fallen Angels) Had Sexual Relations With The Daughters Of Men And Their Offspring Became The Giants Of Old >> It Points To The Frequent Mythological Accounts Like Those In Greek Myths.*
- These same ideas populate the legends of every ancient cultural tradition on Earth: Sumer, Assyria, Egypt, Incas, Mayan, Gilgamesh, etc.
- They all have stories about Nephilim like encounters and societies

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

The Nature of Angels

- They can appear in human form
- On Earth they spoke, took men by the hand, ate meals
- They are strong and mighty.
- Capable of overwhelming physical combat

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

The Origin of Demons

- Demons seem to be distinct from angels: they seek *embodiment*.
- What Happened To The Spirits Of The Nephilim After The Flood?
- Could the demons be the spirits of the Nephilim of Genesis 6?

THE DRASTIC MEASURES OF REDEMPTION

- **JESUS SAID, “DON’T BE DECEIVED”**
- **We Must Protect Ourselves Daily In The Armor Of God**
- **God Has Given Us A Provision For This Age Of Deceit**
- **He Has Given Us Weapons & Armor To Equip Us In This Battle**
- **Our Command Is This**
- **Ephesians 6:10 (NIV)** Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.
