

DECEPTION V. TRUTH

- John 7:24 (NIV) Stop judging by mere appearances, and make a right judgment."
- 2 Thessalonians 2:10 (NIV) (10) and in every sort of evil that deceives those who are perishing. They perish because they refused to love the truth and so be saved.
- Isaiah 5:20 (NIV) (20) Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter.

DECEPTION V. TRUTH

- 1 Timothy 3:9 (NIV) (9) They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience.
- 1 Pet 5:8 (NIV) Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

DECEPTION V. TRUTH

- John 8:31-32 (NIV) ... Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. (32) Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
- Psa 51:6 (NIV) Surely you desire truth in the inner parts; you teach me wisdom in the inmost place.

BITTERNESS V. FORGIVENESS

- Matthew 6:14–15 (NIV) 14 For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.
- **Hebrews 10:17 (NIV) 17** Then he adds: "Their sins and lawless acts I will remember no more."

BITTERNESS V. FORGIVENESS

• Mat 18:21-35 (NIV) Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, "Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother when he sins against me? Up to seven times?" (22) Jesus answered, "I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.
