We Develop The Passion To Pray

Why Did Jesus Say To Pray? Because When We Pray As He Commanded

- We Will See What He Saw (About The Lost)
- We Will Feel What He Felt
- We Will Do What He Did (Regarding The Lost)

We Pray Because Jesus Wants Us To See The World As He Sees It

Prayer Is The Chosen Vehicle Of Communication With God —The Chosen
 Vehicle Of Empowerment By The Spirit

The Two Greatest Prayer Needs Today:

- 1. For The Lost To Recognize Their Desperate Condition.
- 2. For Christians To Follow Christ's Call To Evangelize And To Gather The Harvest

When We Carry A Burden For Our Lost Loved Ones To Be Saved, We Are In Effect Bearing A Measure Of God's Burden

- We Must Allow Ourselves To Receive The Burden Of The Lord.
- We Must Let His Heart For People Become Ours.
- So That When We Pray, It Is Really Him Praying Through Us.

- **2 Corinthians 5:18–20 (NIV)** 18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. 20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

A Reconciler / Ambassador Is A "Pray-er":

- We Pray For Opportunities To Be Used Effectively
- We Pray For Seed We Plant To Be Harvested
- We Pray For Others Who Are Reconcilers To Be Impactful
- We Pray For Opportunities To Be Ambassadors w/Christ's Heart
- We Ask For God's Heart Of Passionate Caring

Prayer Is The Key

- A Specific Type Of Prayer Is The Prayer Of Intercession
- We Pray And Intercede Because We Are Committed To Moving In God's Will And Plan
- The Vehicle That Will Help Us To Accomplish This Is Prayer

- In Intercessory Prayer We Deal Aggressively With The Enemy On Behalf Of Someone Who Needs Our Prayers And Support. We Pray And Come Against The Enemy In The All-Powerful Name Of The Lord Jesus Christ And With The "Sword Of The Spirit"—The Word Of God.
- We Stand Before God On Behalf Of The Person We Are Praying For -- At The Same Time, We Stand Between The Enemy And The Person For Whom We Are

- Intercession Is Covering Someone, Picking Off The Enemy's Fire
 - -- So They Can Keep Advancing
- Intercession Requires The Help Of The Holy Spirit.
- In This, The Highest Element Of Prayer, God's Spirit Gives Breath To Our Prayers.
- Intercession Is Standing In The Gap For Someone In Need Of God's Intervention

Things That Are Cold And Lifeless Are Not Too Big Of A Challenge

We Need The Presence, Power And Breath Of Life, From The Lord
