## Seasons

- 1. Share about a time you went through an exciting change, like moving to a new place, starting a new job, or a new relationship. What made it exciting for you?
- 2. In Ecclesiastes 3:1-8, we see that there is a season for everything in life. How does this passage help you view changes, both expected and unexpected? How does it speak to our current season of change as a church family?
- 3. Acts 20:36-38 shows the deep emotions Paul and the Ephesian elders experienced during their farewell. Have you ever experienced strong emotions during a season of change, whether in your personal life or within the church? How did you process those emotions?
- 4. Joshua 1:9 reminds us that God is with us wherever we go. As someone who was named after this verse, Pastor Josh shared how it has guided him through changes. How does the assurance of God's presence impact your ability to face change, especially in challenging times?
- 5. Reflect on the current changes in your life and in our church. What steps can you take this week to expect change, embrace your emotions, and experience God's presence more deeply as you navigate these transitions? How can our group support one other in this?
