How can you incorporate worship, prayer, Bible reading, or other spiritual growth opportunities into your marriage to deepen your spiritual connection?
5. What is one specific thing you can do this week to enhance intimacy in your marriage, whether it's a physical, emotional, or spiritual aspect? Share your action plan with the group and encourage one another to follow through.
