Reflect on specific areas such as marriage, parenting, health, finances, etc., and share how choosing to approach those aspects of life God's way has been beneficial.

4. Is there an area of your life right now where you might feel off the path? Share about it, and let's encourage one another with the truth that God is watching and waiting for us, ready to welcome us back with open arms.

5. Close your time together in prayer, asking for guidance and strength to stay on God's path of righteousness, and seeking His grace and mercy in the areas where we may have strayed.
