



## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

### Unusual God - Part 3

1. We are three weeks into this current series, “Unusual God.” What are you learning about God and how is it impacting your life?
2. Read Exodus 22:21-27. Who are the “vulnerable” as described in these verses? What do these groups of people all have in common that makes them vulnerable?
3. Read Psalm 27:10, Psalm 146:5-9, and Psalm 68:4-6. What do we learn about God’s nature in these verses? Specifically, how does God feel toward the vulnerable?
4. In John 14:9 Jesus said “The one who has seen Me has seen the Father.” How did Jesus display God’s heart toward the vulnerable on Earth?
5. Read James 1:27 and Matthew 25:35-40. How do these verses describe what our role is in regard to caring for the vulnerable?

Think for a moment about someone in your life who is or may be vulnerable. What could you do to help care for them and meet their needs?
