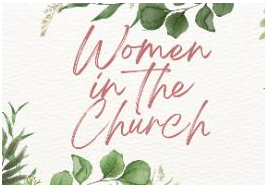


THE CHILD PROTECTION CLASS will be this evening at 5:00 P.M. in the Fellowship Hall.
