“For Freedom” – Galatians 5:1 (NASB)

I. Walk in “Freedom”—Galatians 5:1a

- A. Jesus is Free. He is the Truth, and He sets people free—Galatians 5:1a; John 14:6.
- B. Jesus Speaks Words of Freedom—John 6:63, 68-69
- C. Jesus Promised Freedom—John 8:31-32.
- D. Jesus Sets People “*free indeed*”—John 8:36

II. Wage War “Standing Firm”—Galatians 5:1b

- A. Bull-dozer Sturdy—Ephesians 6:11
- B. Bad Battles Come—Ephesians 6:10-20.
- C. Believers Believe This—Galatians 5:1.

III. Watch Out for Traps—Galatians 5:1c

- A. *Past*—“*do not be subject again...*”
- B. *Present*—“*a yoke of slavery*” is a not a good yoke.
- C. *Future*—“*Slavery*” is not God’s Will, past, present, or future.

Four Facts to Live By:

1. God is Free, never enslaved.
2. God made you to be Free, never enslaved.
3. Jesus died and rose again to assure you His kind of freedom.
4. Receive what He gives and live in the “*Freedom*” He desires. He Died and Arose for it and Lives to Give that Now, Day by Day and Forever.
