 - A. The Word of God—Isaiah 50:4.
 - 1. Speak to each child, especially the Word.
 - 2. Give truth to each child.
 - 3. Provide Daily Bread and Eternal Bread for Fulness of Life.
 - 4. Lead to Jesus, Salvation, and an Obedient Life.
 - B. The Way. Know and Show the Way Forward—Deuteronomy 6:5-9.
 - 1. Worship God.
 - 2. Know God's Word.
 - 3. Talk to God.
 - 4. Walk with God.
 - C. Wisdom. Prize Wisdom from God—Proverbs 4.
 - 1. From earliest days.
 - 2. Walk in the Light God gives.
 - 3. Practice Life from the Heart aligned with God.
 - D. Walk. Learn to Walk—Ephesians 6:4.
 - 1. Know what it means to grow.
 - 2. Know when to say "No," "Slow," "Go," or "Grow."

- II. Don't Provoke or Exasperate a Child—Ephesians 6:4; Colossians 3:21.
 - A. Clarify Expectations—Ephesians 6:4
 - **B.** Certify Encouragements
 - 1. Nullify whatever is discouraging—Colossians 3:21
 - 2. Amplify whatever is encouraging—Proverbs 22:6
 - 3. Exemplify spirit priority—Acts 24:16
- III. A Godly Father is a Peacemaker—1 Thessalonians 2:11
 - A. Spend time with each child—come near—2:11.
 - B. Speak to where each child is—live here—2:11.
 - C. Set the pace for peace—deal with fears—2:11
- IV. A Godly Father Plans Ahead—1 Thessalonians 2:11
 - A. Pray, Pray, Pray!
 - **B.** Parable Perspective.
 - C. Plot out what is clear about God's Will.
 - D. Pray for God's Plans. What Now? Not? Next? New?
- V. A Godly Father Prays and Seeks the Blessing of Jesus
 - A. Come to Jesus, seeking His Blessing—Mark 10:13-16
 - B. Talk to Jesus—Matthew 19:13-15
 - C. Bless in Jesus' Name—Numbers 6:24-26
 - D. Encourage others to Bless each child—1 Thessalonians 5:11

Four Family Factors:

- 1. Treat each child as a Gift from God.
- 2. Pray for each child, for God's Will and Ways.
- 3. Love each child, being led by the Spirit.
- 4. Make sure each child knows he or she is Accountable to God.
