 - B. Of what spiritual significance is this test that God gives to Abraham? (See Genesis 15:1-5 and 17:21)
 - C. When Isaac asked, "Where is the lamb for the burnt offering?" how did Abraham respond?
 - D. What did Abraham name Mt. Moriah?
 - E. What does this name tell us about God?

 - A. What is one thing that you need that you could trust God to provide for you?
 - B. Take a moment to pray and ask God for it. Then thank Him for answering and being your provider.
