Music Notes with Pam...

We are raising the roof with praise songs this week!

Prelude: "Jesus Loves Me" is the best loved children's song of all time and will be played on flute by Harriet McDonald. Published in 1860 by Presbyterian writer Anna Warner, it was written as a poem to bring comfort to a dying child and was set to music two years later.

Song of Praise: "This Is the Day" is a direct quotation of Psalm 118:24 set to a folk tune from Fiji. Scripture choruses are a great way to teach Bible verses, and the appeal of this 1967 song of praise is the possibility of singing it antiphonally with two groups singing in alternation.

Opening Hymn: "This Is My Father's World" was written by Presbyterian minister Maltbie Babcock. Upon his death at age 43, it was published in a collection of his writings Thoughts for Everyday Living. The tune, TERRA BEATA, means beautiful world and is a traditional English melody.

Anthem: "Let the People Praise" is the finale of the children's musical, "It's Cool In the Furnace" by Buryl Red. The children enjoy all the instruments it incorporates. I have enjoyed memories of singing the part of Meshach in 1973 (even though I was a girl) because no one else could hold the middle harmony between Shadrach and Abednego! Harriet remembers

when it was presented here at Highland...maybe you do too!

Closing Song: "Hallelu, Hallelujah" will be a festive closing song for VBS children and congregation to sing together as the children wave jubilation streamers bringing this wonderful week of VBS to an exciting conclusion!
